

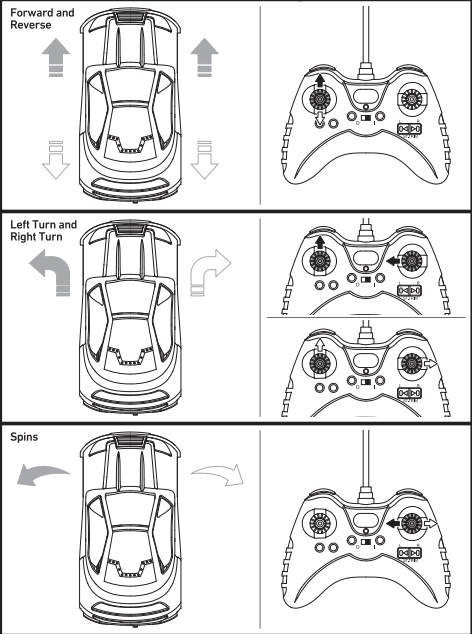

## TIPS & TROUBLESHOOTING

### TIPS

1. Clean the two drive tires with a damp cloth before each session. The four "normal" wheels don't turn.
  2. Find a smooth non-porous surface – A bumpy wall means that your car will lose suction and fall off.
  3. Only drive on empty walls – running into pictures is a good way to cause your car to fall. It's also a good way to make the picture fall as well. Don't drive on walls with anything underneath/against them as a falling car could be damaged or cause damage.
  4. Don't run over light switches, outlets or any other obstacle. They're worse than speedbumps.
  5. Do not run into other walls, or off the edge.
  6. Do not stand under the car when driving on the ceiling.
- Driving on Walls:**
- Note: Climbing function is only available when switch is set to CLIMB.
  - Before turning controller ON, make sure that both joysticks are in the neutral (centered) position.
  - Turn the controller ON.
  - Select CLIMB (all the way to the left) on the switch on the back of the car.
  - You must place the car against the wall with the wheels against the surface.

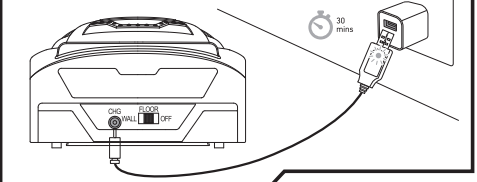
### GETTING STARTED

**Fully charge car before use!**

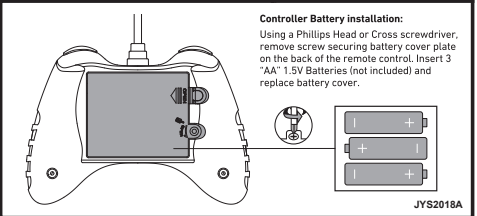
The car contains a rechargeable battery. Connect USB plug to any standard USB port and insert micro connector into rear of car next to mode switch. The red charging light will illuminate to show it is being charged. When the car is fully charged, (about 30 minutes) the light will turn off.

The car can only be charged while the power switch is in the "OFF" position.

A full battery charge will last for approximately 8 to 9 minutes of wall driving and longer for driving on the floor or other horizontal surface.

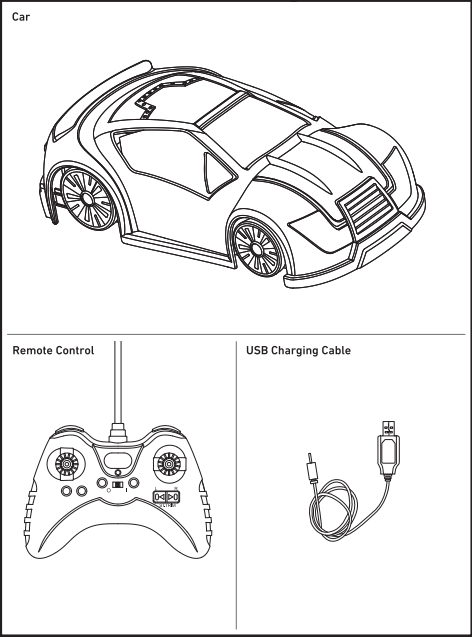

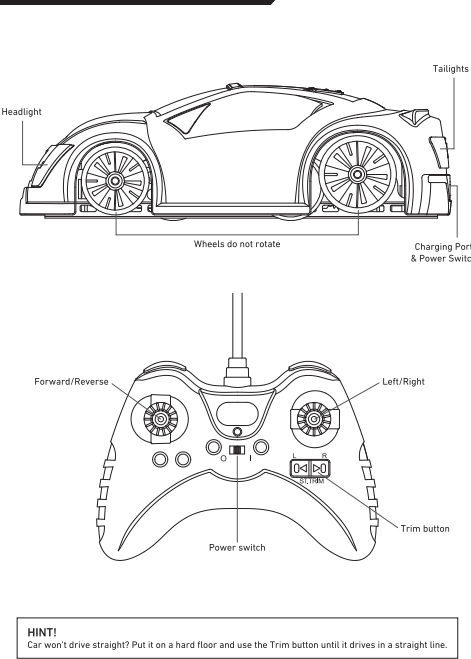
