RE: Confidentiality request letter for Model R20 Radar, FCC ID 2APIM-FTR20SKYD

To whom it may concern:

We are requesting that the following documents be removed from the OET Exhibits List for the model R20 radar (FCC ID 2APIM-FTR20SKYD):

- Internal photos. Contains photos of the internal components of the radar, including sensitive photos of the PCBs, critical components, and design.
- User Manual. Contains sensitive information about the operation of the R20 radar, which could be used to help defeat its operation. This user manual is not normally available to the general public, but is only made available to perspective Fortem customers after signing an NDA.
- These documents are (or will soon be) listed in the original 2APIM-FTR20SKYD listing as well as the Class II permissive change. Please make them confidential for all of the listings.

We request that these documents be held in a state of long-term confidentiality and removed from the FCC equipment granting list of documents for the following reasons:

- The nature and use of the Model R20 radar is intended for multiple type use including commercial and industrial safety and security, as well as for defense, including national defense. The R20 export classification currently falls under the International Traffic in Arms Regulation (ITAR) as defined in 22 CFR 120-130.
- Per 47 CFR Chapter I Subchapter A Part 0.457 and also Part 0.459, the photos and manual can divulge information that could possibly jeopardize national defense.
