

BUILD YOUR OWN REMOTE CONTROL FOAM AIRPLANE

Components:

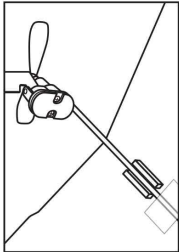
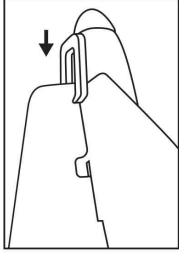
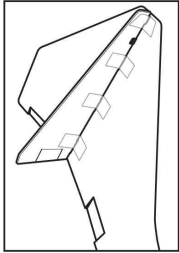
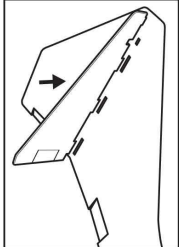
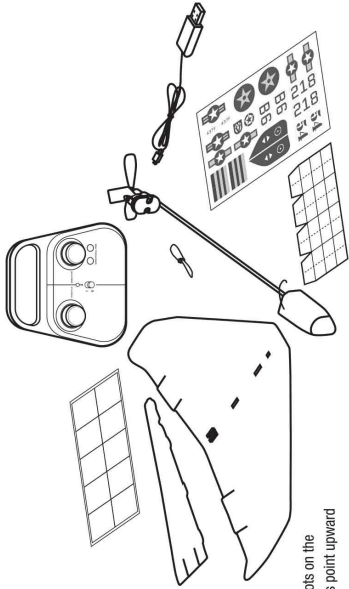
1. Plane Wings
2. Plane Keel
3. Control and Power Module
4. Remote Control
5. USB Charging Cable
6. Spare Propeller
7. Adhesive Tabs
8. Stickers

Charging:

1. Connect the charging cable to the power socket on the Control Module. The plug is directional. Do not force.
2. Plug the USB end into any standard 5V USB port or charger.
3. The red light in the USB plug will remain lit until the module is fully charged.
4. A full charge takes 45-60 minutes for up to 8 minutes of flight.

Assembly:

1. Assemble the plane upside down. Insert the tabs in the keel (fuselage) into the slots on the wings. The keel goes underneath the wings. The winglets on the end of the wings point upward when in flight.
2. Secure the keel to the wings using the clear adhesive tabs. Make sure the keel is at right angles to the wings. The clips themselves should go on the front of the plane. Slide it all the way up to the end of the clips. The clips themselves should go on either side of the keel.
3. Press the shaft connecting the Control and Power Modules between the raised braces on the wings. Secure with a clear adhesive tab placed just in front of the braces.
4. Decorate the plane with the stickers as desired.

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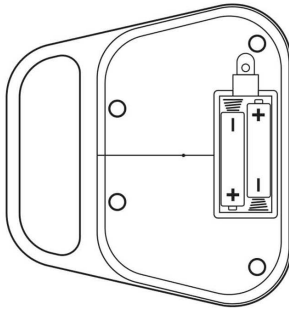
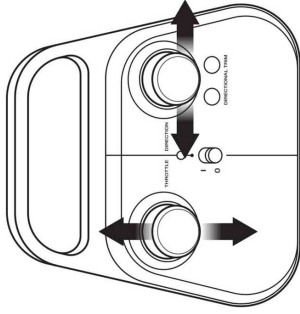
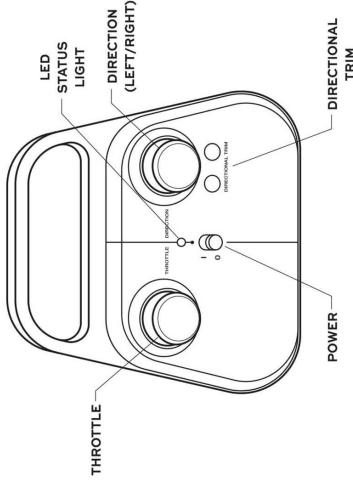
Operation:

PAIRING

1. Fully charge the Plane.
2. Turn on the Remote. The LED status light will flash rapidly.
3. Turn on the Plane. The switch is located above the charging port.
4. When the light on the Remote stops flashing and remains on, the Plane is paired with the Remote and is ready for flight.

Flight:

- Keep the Plane – especially propeller – away from face, hair and jewelry while in use. Do not pick up Plane while propeller is spinning. Do not aim at people or animals. In case of entanglement, turn Plane and Remote off. Remove propeller by sliding off shaft to untangle.
- The throttle controls the speed. Move it forward for maximum power, or all the way down to turn off the motor.
 - To launch, move the throttle to maximum power (all the way up) and throw like a paper airplane.
 - Climb or dive by using the throttle.
 - Use the right joystick to make the Plane turn left or right.
 - If the Plane constantly drifts one way or the other, use the directional trim buttons to bring it back to center. If the Plane drifts left, push the right trim button, and vice-versa.



INSERT 2 "AAA" 1.5V BATTERY INTO REMOTE

BATTERY WARNING:
