BLUETOOTH PAIRING:

Connect: Long press the power on button about 5 seconds, then blue and red lights flash, search the bluetooth name "Q13" on your device, you could play music after successful connected.

1. Make calls:

You could make calls after the bluetooth earphone connected with your device. There have calls reminder and calling number when calls coming. Short press the power on button to answer calls, double click the button to reject calls. Double click under play music state could redial the latest call number.

2. Play music:

You could play music after the bluetooth earphone connected with your device. Short press could pause or play music. Long press about 1.5 seconds with voice prompt could play next song.

3. Power off:

Long press the button until the red and blue led light flash. The bluetooth earphone will auto power off if without any device connected.

CHARGING:

Adopt to Nokia mini charging port, 80 minutes can make 100% full battery. When low battery, the red led light will flash and need charging. The red light will always on when charging, when full charging the red light will turn to blue light.

NOTES:

1. Please do not use the profits to treat this product, do not squeeze with heavy objects, away from high temperature and humidity environment.
2. Away from WiFi routers and other high-frequency transmitting equipment, this will affect the local signal reception, resulting in the sound disconnected.
3. Please use this product in the effective environment (10 meters), and there should be no physical barrier between the Bluetooth device and the earphone (such as the wall).
4. This product can be used with any Bluetooth device.
