01 Download App

Scan the QR code or search "Innerpeace" in the app store to download the application.



02 Add Luuna

Register and press Me - Add Device. Then follow the instructions to add Luuna.



04 Wear

Put on Luuna and make sure forehead sensors are in good contact with your skin.

03 Connect Luuna

After adding it, open the app before you use it. Luuna will be automatically connected to the phone if it's nearby and the indicator light turns blue.



05 Charging

The indicator will turn red and blink slowly if the battery is low. Detach the control box and charge it with the cable. When the battery is full, the indicator light will be green.

06 Storage

After you close the app, Luuna will sleep automatically. No need to shut it down. Do not fold the device when it is stored.
