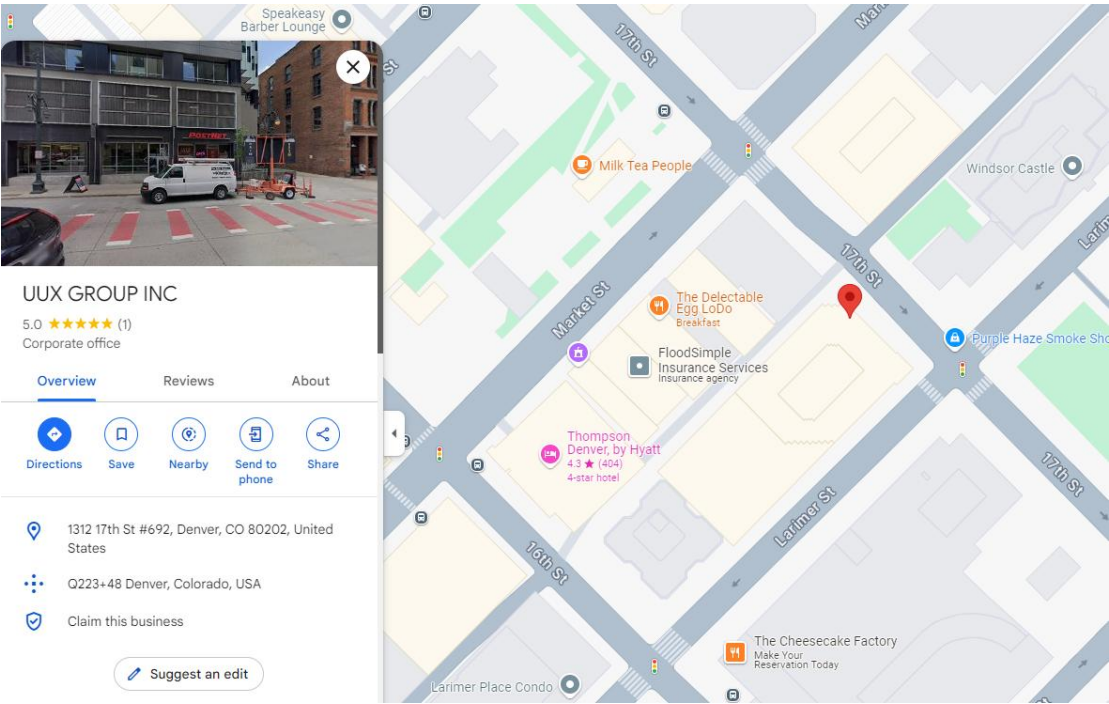

An agent for service of process for the particular equipment certification authorization has the obligation to accept the service of process and other legal process documents on behalf of the grantee of the authorization (the responsible party) and to swiftly and dutifully deliver them to that party. Service of process includes, but is not limited to, delivery of any correspondence, notices, orders, decisions, and requirements of administrative, legal, or judicial process related to Commission proceedings. See FCC 22-84, paragraph 63. However, service of process on the grantee of the equipment authorization is deemed to be complete when the document is sent to the U.S. physical address, U.S. mailing address (if different), or e-mail address of the U.S.-based agent for service of process.


