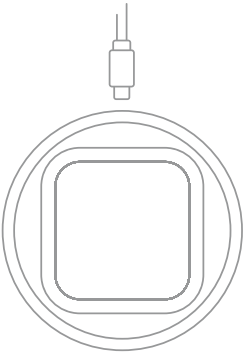

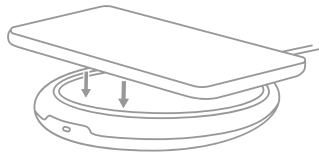
- 1 Connect cable to charge pad
Connecter le câble au bloc de charge



- 2 Connect cable to wall charger
Connecter le câble au chargeur mural



- 3 Plug in wall charger
Brancher le chargeur mural



- 4 Place smartphone face up on pad
Placer le smartphone sur la station avec l'écran vers le haut



- 5 Charging starts upon contact
Le chargement démarre lors du contact

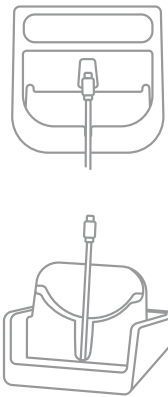


- 6 LEDs flash briefly during device recognition
Les LEDs clignotent brièvement quand elles reconnaissent l'appareil

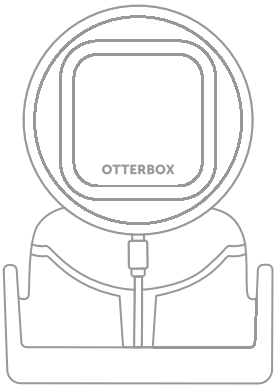


- 7 LEDs glow solid while charging
Les LEDs restent allumées pendant le chargement

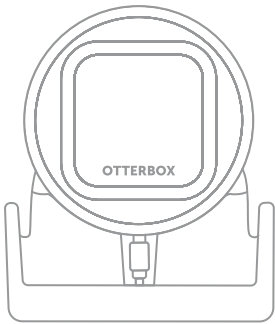

- 1 Route cable through stand
Faites passer le câble dans le support



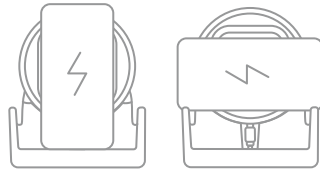
- 2 Plug cord into charging pad
Branchez le cordon d'alimentation à la station de charge



- 3 Slide pad into holder, logo facing out
Faites glisser la station dans le support, logo vers l'extérieur



- 4 Secure cable into channel
Insérez le câble dans la rainure



- 5 Place smartphone on stand
Placez le smartphone sur le support
