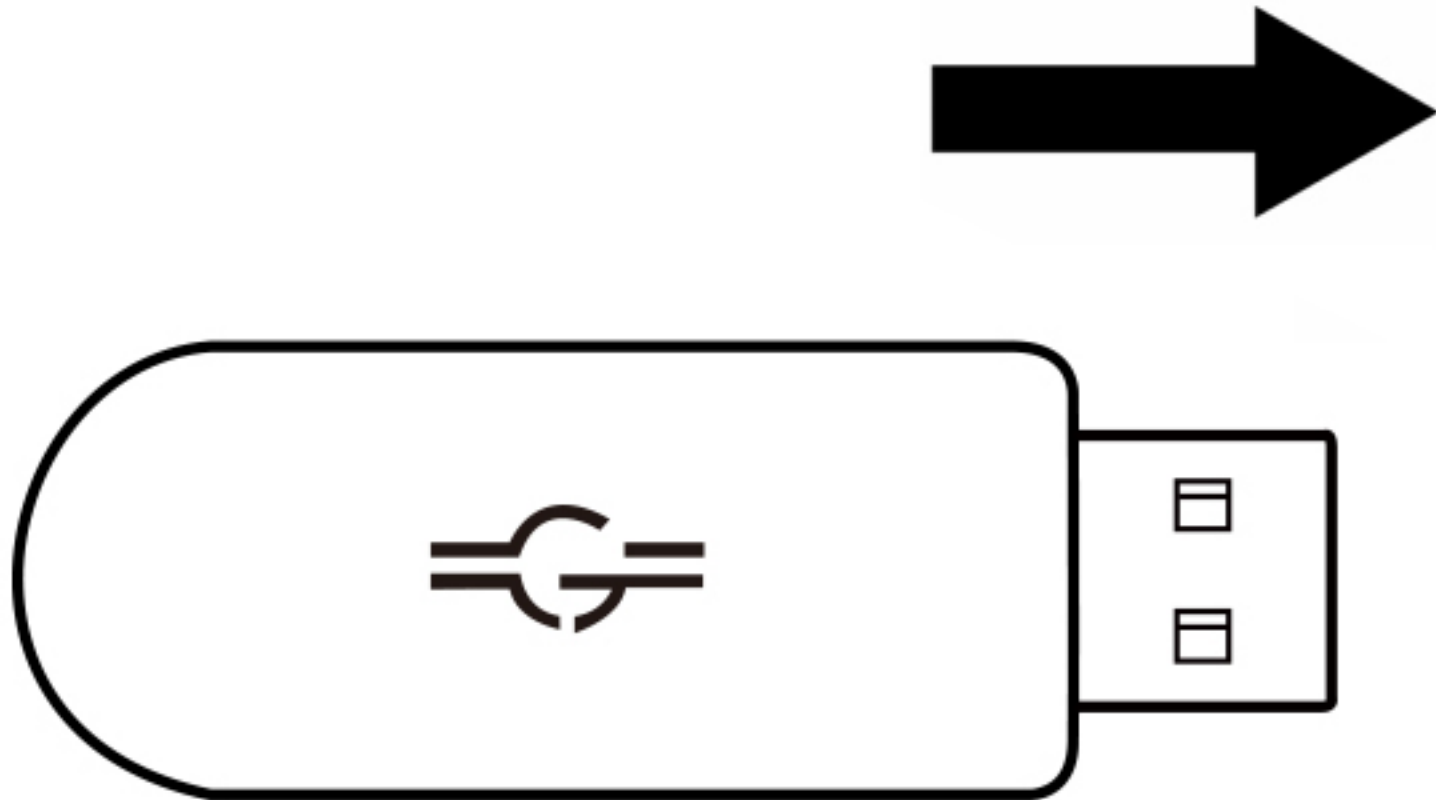
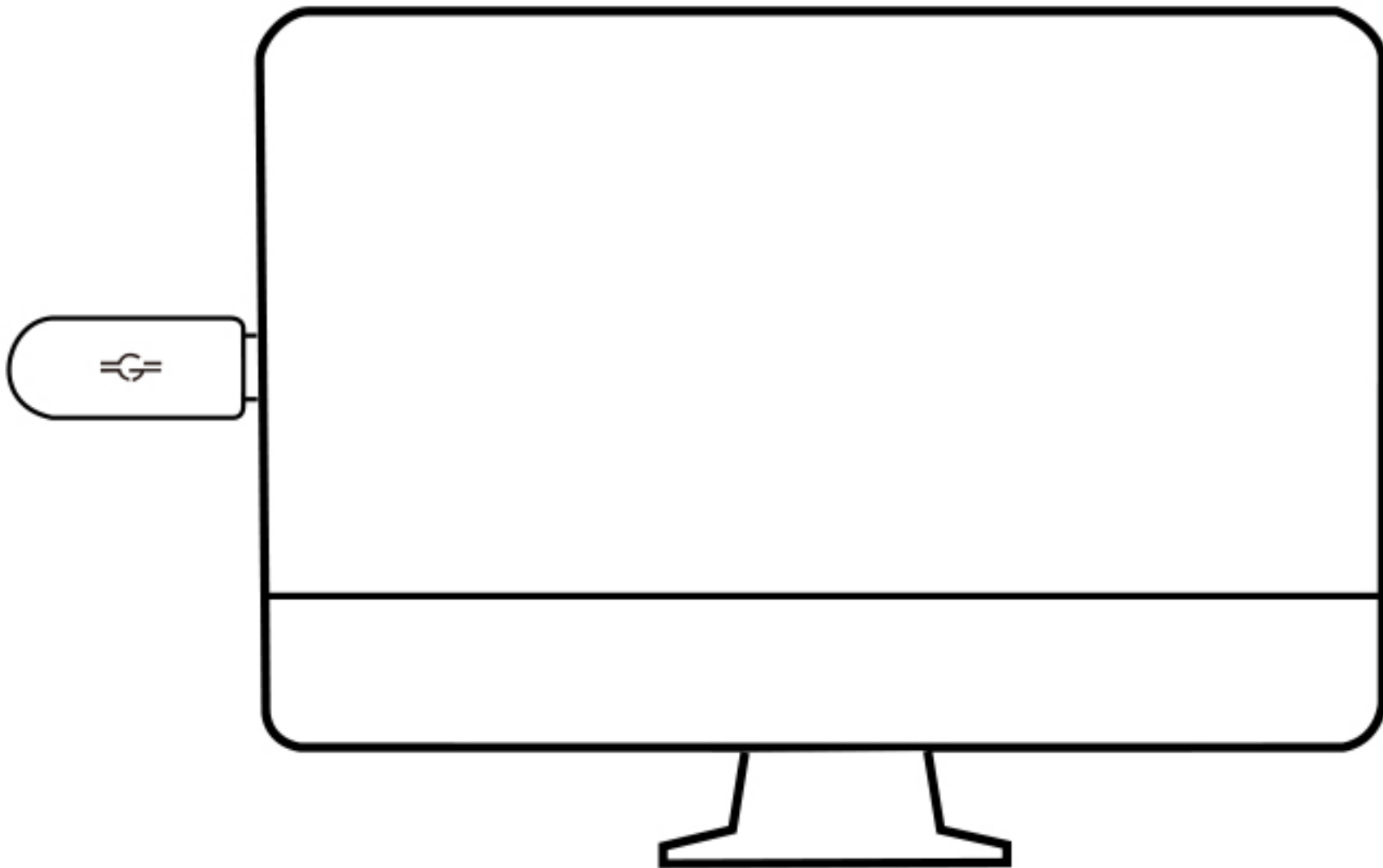


1, this usb dongle is working with gravio。it's a zigbee Wireless Gateway work on 2.4g



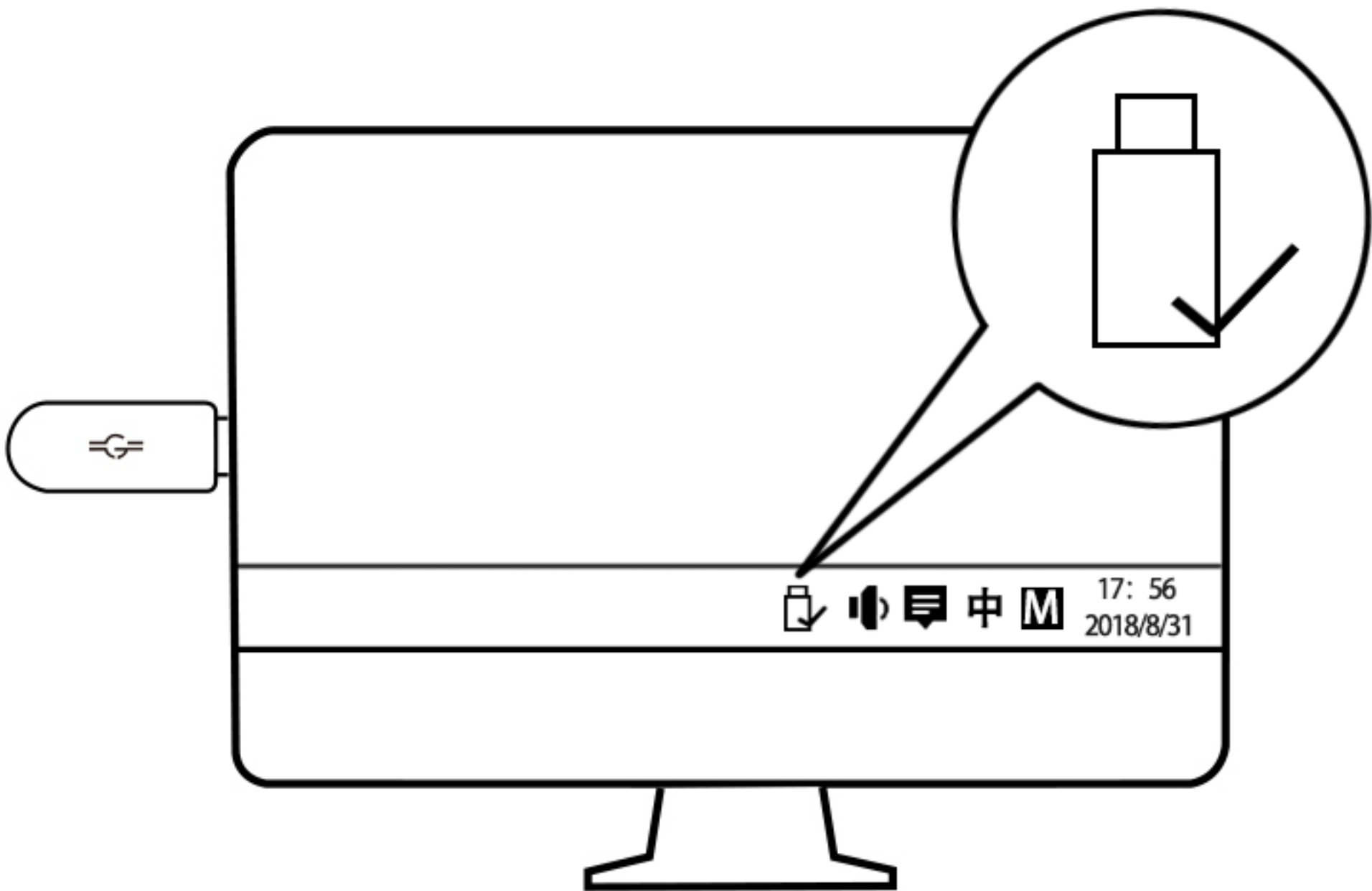

2, it is a simple design.you can use it very easy,push it in to your pc's usb port



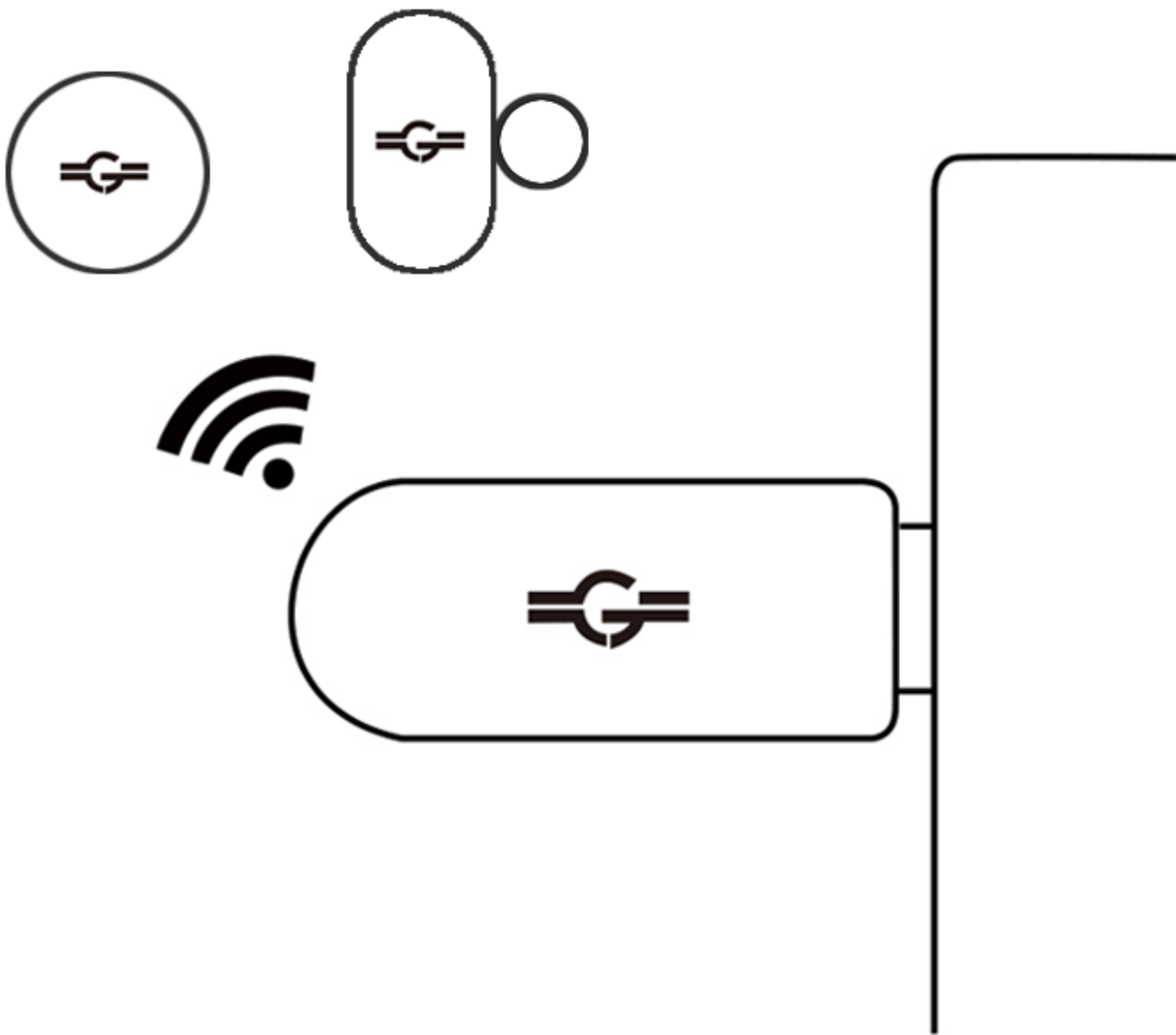

3, when you insert dongle ,the driver will auto indstall,and your windows will show driver is ready on desktop foot



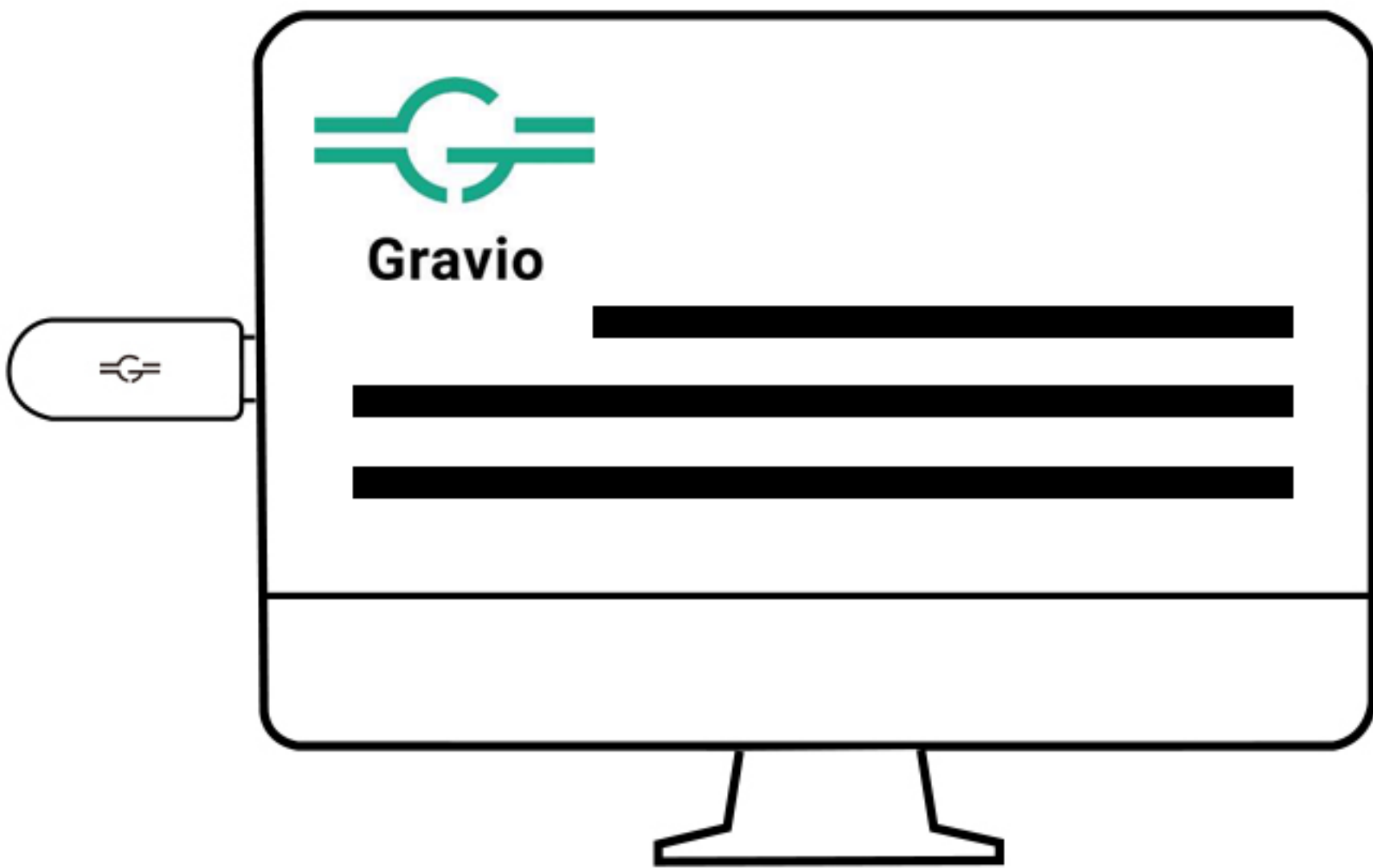
