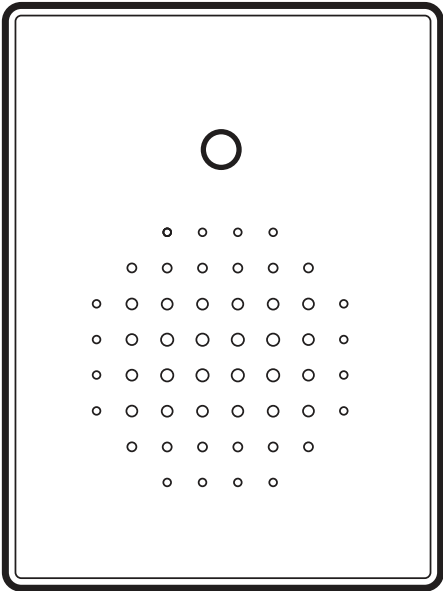

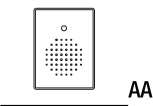
### FCC STATEMENT

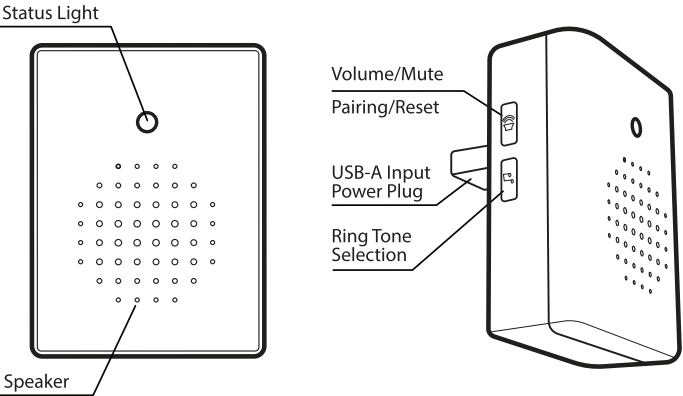

Description

ITEM	DESCRIPTION
Status Light	Once plugged into power the indicator will blink twice then turn off.
Volume/Mute Pairing/ Reset	Press and hold the volume button for 6 seconds or until the light indicator blinks rapidly. It will be in pairing mode for 15 seconds, during this time press the doorbell button on the front of the camera. Press the button again to hear it ring.  Press the volume button to toggle between high, medium, low, and mute sound settings.
Ring Tone Selection	Cycle through 20 different tones.
USB-A Input Power Plug	5VDC, Max. 1A



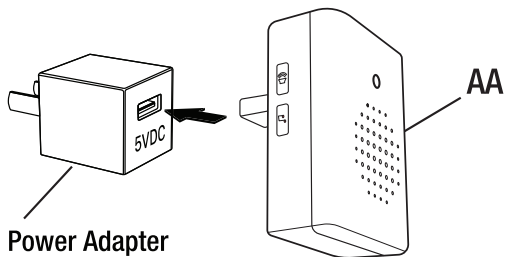
## 1 Supply Power

Supply power to your Wireless Chime (AA) with the USB power adapter near the Smart Doorbell. You can relocate it after pairing the device.



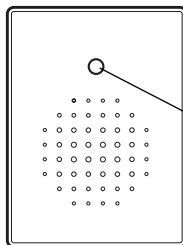
**NOTE:** The USB power adapter is not included.

## 2 Confirm Status Light

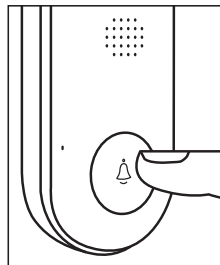
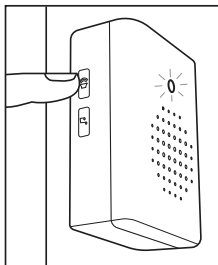
Wait for the Status Light to blink twice then turn off.

## 3 Pair with Smart Doorbell

Press and hold the volume button until the light indicator blinks quickly, then release the button and press the doorbell button on the front of the camera.



## 4 Complete Setup

Press it again to make sure it rings. You are now paired.



**NOTE:** Tapping on the Ring Tone Selection button cycles through all 20 tones. It will play by default once you have stopped cycling.
