To Whom it may concern,

We are seeking a Class II permissive change for application of the FCC ID: 2AQ8D-RX-2 Cat M cellular modem used in the Model RX-1 mini Rhythm Express Remote Cardiac Monitor. The applicable rule parts are 47 CFR part 27 the other operational modes under parts 22H, 24E, and 90 are not part of this application. The current FCC ID is 2AQ8D-RX-2.

The body worn torso device (RX-2) RX-1 mini uses this modularly approved device as described in the application literature for the modem and has not modified the hardware or software of the approved module. The RX-1-mini uses an antenna that meets the requirements specified by the manufacturer for the modem in agreement with its approval.

The RX-1 mini limits the output power through duty cycle 12% maximum of the modem to allow for use within 20 cm (specifically 14.25mm) of the torso on the body.
