

General Operation:

1. Power ON/OFF Switch

POWER SOURCE

The unit has a built-in Li-Ion rechargeable battery, charge it before first time use or when it is drained as follows:

1. Connect the unit to the DC 5V (Micro USB) Connection Cable to the DC 5V (Micro USB) Port on the unit.
2. Connect the full size USB Plug from the supplied USB Connection Cable to the USB Port on the Personal Computer or USB Charger (Computer and USB Charger not included).

3. When charging, the Red Charging Indicator on the unit will illuminate.

4. When charging is complete, the Red Charging Indicator will turn off.



NOTES:

1. While charging, you can also play and listen to music at the same time.
2. Your battery will last longer if you follow these simple guidelines for caring and storing:

A. Avoid frequent recharging the unit approximately 4 hours until the unit is fully charged.

B. Charge and store the unit within the temperature range of

First time use or re-pairing the unit to a new BT Device, pair as follows:

1. Power on the unit and enter to BT mode as previously instructed. You will hear an audible prompt say "Bluetooth pairing" and the Decorative Lights on the unit will illuminate.

2. Power on the external BT Device and enter to BT search mode. Start pairing following the on screen instructions on the external BT Device. Once paired, the unit will sound a prompt "Bluetooth connected".

3. If pairing is complete you may now play music and answer the phone with your external BT Device.
4. During playback:

1. Press the BT Button on the unit to pause, press again to resume to normal playback.

2. Press and release the **←** or **→** buttons repeatedly to adjust the volume level as desired.

3. Press and hold the **←** or **→** buttons repeatedly to skip tracks.

4. When finished listening, sliding the Power ON/OFF Switch to OFF position to shut off the unit.

When the external BT Device searches for the unit, our model number "MMA3790" will appear on the display of the external BT Device.

5. If pairing you are asked for a code, please try "0000" or "1234".

Notes after pairing:

1. Power on the BT Device to pause, press again to resume to normal playback.
2. Press and release the **←** or **→** buttons repeatedly to adjust the volume level as desired.
3. Press and hold the **←** or **→** buttons repeatedly to skip tracks.

4. After pairing is complete you may now play music and answer calls with your external BT Device.

1. Up to 32 GB TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device supported.

2. When inserting the TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device, make sure the direction you selected is correct. Never insert violently to avoid damaging the TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device. If it doesn't work, please check if the direction is correct.

3. You also need to download the desired music in MP3 format into the TF (Micro SD) Card/USB Device before insert into the unit.

4. During playback:

1. Press the **BT** Button on the unit to pause, press again to resume to normal playback.

2. Press and release the **←** or **→** buttons repeatedly to adjust volume level as desired.

3. Press and hold the **←** or **→** buttons repeatedly to skip tracks.

4. When finished listening, sliding the Power ON/OFF Switch to OFF position to shut off the unit.

TF (Micro SD) Card:

To play music in a TF (Micro SD) Card:

1. Insert the TF (Micro SD) Card (not included) into the TF (Micro SD) Card Slot on the unit with contacts facing to USB Port as illustrated below:



2. Enter to TF (Micro SD) Card mode as previously instructed:

1. You will hear an audible prompt say "Memory Card".

2. Music in the card will be played back automatically.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Check the following before requesting service:

SYMPTOM	Possible Cause	Possible Solution
Can't power on.	The unit is in power off mode.	Press the Power ON/OFF Switch to On.
Volume of the unit was set to minimum position.	Volume level of the unit is in low level.	Increase the volume level to maximum position.
No sound or sound is weak.	Volume level of the unit is in low level.	Press and release the ← or → buttons repeatedly to increase the volume level.
Sound distortion.	Volume level of the unit is too high.	Reduce the volume level of the unit to a moderate level.
BT not functioning.	The external BT Device did NOT pair with the unit.	For the external BT Device to the unit, please insert into the unit and press the BT button.
