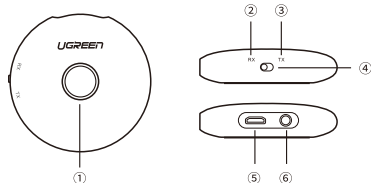

Switch Button</div><div>5. Micro USB Power Port</div><div>6. 3.5mm Audio Jack</div></div></div><div>- 1 -</div></div> | <div><div>How It Works</div><div><div>1. Transmitter (TX) Mode</div><p>Slide the switch button to the TX mode.</p><div><div><div>TV</div><div>PC</div><div>Bluetooth Speaker</div><div>Bluetooth Headphones</div></div></div><p>Connect and Pair for the First Time</p><div><div>1. Use the provided 3.5mm audio cable to connect this transmitter to your computer or TV.</div><div>2. Press the button for 3 seconds to turn on this transmitter. And it will enter pair mode with red and blue light alternately flashes.</div><div>3. Keep your Bluetooth headphone or speaker in the transmitting range of 10m and turn on your Bluetooth headphone or speaker. This transmitter will automatically pair with your device.</div><div>4. Play music on your computer or TV and start to enjoy wireless audio.</div><div>5. When you restart this transmitter next time, it will reconnect to the Bluetooth device automatically.</div><div>6. Press the button for 3 seconds to turn off this transmitter.</div></div><p>Two-point Connection Function</p><p>This transmitter can connect two Bluetooth devices at the same time and we take device A and device B as an example.</p></div><div>- 2 -</div></div> | <div><div><div>1. Make sure the distance between two Bluetooth devices should not exceed 5 meters.</div><div>2. Pair this transmitter with device A as mentioned above and TURN OFF device A.</div><div>3. Double click the button to enter pair mode and turn on device B. This transmitter will automatically pair with device B.</div><div>4. Turn on device A and this transmitter will re-connect with device A.</div><div>5. Play music on your computer or TV. Now you can share wireless audio with your friend.</div><div>6. When you restart this transmitter next time, it will reconnect to this two connected devices automatically.</div></div><div><div>Note:</div><p>The transmitter can only transmit audio from computer/TV to your Bluetooth headphone/speaker and cannot connect computer/TV to your mobile phone.</p></div><div><div>2. Receiver (RX) Mode</div><p>Slide the switch button to the RX mode.</p><div><div><div>Mobile</div><div>Tablet</div><div>Speaker</div><div>Headphones</div></div></div></div><div>- 3 -</div></div> | <div><div>Connect and Pair</div><div><div>1. Put this receiver into the transmit range of 10m/32ft and use the provided audio cable to connect this receiver to your 3.5mm/2RCA headphoneorspeaker.</div><div>2. Press the button for 3 seconds to turn on this receiver. And it will enter pair mode with red and blue light alternately flashes.</div><div>3. Enable the Bluetooth function of yourphone and start the search for Bluetooth device. (Please refer to the user manual of your cell phone)</div><div>4. You will find the "Ugreen-40762E in your cell phone list and select it to pair your phone with this receiver.</div><div>5. Play music on your phone and start to enjoy wireless audio.</div><div>6. When you restart this receiver next time, it will reconnect to your phone automatically.</div><div>7. Press the button for 3 seconds to turn off this receiver.</div></div><div><div>Note:</div><p>If this receiver cannot find a device to pair with within 5 minutes, it will automatically shut down.</p></div><div><div>Two-point Connection Function</div><p>This receiver can connect two phones at the same time and we take phone A and phone B as an example.</p><div><div>1. Make sure the distance between two phones should not exceed 5 meters.</div></div></div></div> <div>- 4 -</div> | <div><div><div>2. Pair this receiver with phone A as mentioned above and TURN OFF Bluetooth function of phone A. This receiver will enter pair mode with red and blue light alternately flashes.</div><div>3. Pair this receiver with phone B as mentioned above.</div><div>4. Enable Bluetooth function of phone A and this receiver will reconnect with phone A.</div><div>5. When you restart this receiver next time, it will reconnect to this two connected phones automatically.</div></div><div><div>Note:</div><p>DO NOT play music on phone A and phone B at the same time.</p></div><div><div>3. Button Function</div><div><div>* Under TX mode, double-click the button to enter the pair mode if you want to pair with another Bluetooth device.</div><div>* If you are out the transmit range of 10m for more than five minutes,click the button to re-connect your device when back to the effective range.</div><div>* Long press the button for 10 seconds and you can reset the unit to factory settings with blue light on for 2.5sec.</div></div></div><div><div>4. Charging This Unit</div><p>When the red LED indicator starts to flash, you need to charge the unit in time.</p></div><div>- 5 -</div></div> |
| <div><div><div>1. Charge the unit completely before the first time use.</div><div>2. Use Micro USB cable (included) and wall charger (not included) to connect this unit to power source.</div><div>3. When you charge with this unit on, the red indicator stays on all the time and the blue indicator light flashes according to connection status; when you charge with this unit off, the red indicator stays on all the time.</div><div>4. When this unit is fully charged, the LED indicator will stay blue.</div></div><div><div>Safety Notes</div><div><div>1. Works with 5V±5% power supply, exceeding range of standard voltage may cause damage to the product or lead to unintended safety problems.</div><div>2. The unit should not be placed near the magnet or products with a strong magnetic field, which will affect the normal function of the unit or damage the unit.</div><div>3. Avoid using this unit in extreme high or low temperatures and humid environments.</div><div>4. The unit is radio signal. Please make sure there is no other signal interference.</div><div>5.
