To charge Battery

Before the first use of bluetooth headset battery must be full of charge firstly

- 1.The charger wire connected to the charging socket on the headset.
- 2.Insert the charger into the power switch.
- 3.The charging indicator light shows red, once fully charged, the blue light glows.
- 4.To isolate the charger from the headset and power socket.
- 5.The charging is complete.

ON/OFF switch machine

- 1.Boot:hold down the start/end call button for about 6 seconds, until the alternating red and blue.
- 2.To turn it off:hold down the start/end call about 3 seconds, until closed.

Chinese and English switching

- 1.After the headset is turned on, press the function key for 2 times.

To pair the Headset With a Bluetooth Enabled Phone

- 1.Open the headset,hold down the function keys about 6 seconds to red and blue lights flashing.
- 2.Set the phone to search for bluetooth devices.
- 3.When the phone search to headphones,search to the list to determine the headphones.
- 4.If the pairing is successful,blue lights will flash,at this point the standby mode are ready to dial/accept the call.

To Answer a Call

Press the start/end call button on the headset.

To end a call

Press the start/end call button on the headset.

To Reject a Call

When the phone rings continue to hold the start/end call button on the the headphones for about 2 second.

To Redial the Last called Number

- 1.In standby mode click headsets start/end call for about 2 seconds to loosen.

Song switch up and down

- 1.Press the volumekey on the headset,loosen then switch on the previous song.
- 2.Press the volumekey on the headset,loosen then switch to the next song.

To Adjust Volume of Headset

- 1.Hold down the volumekey on the headset to increase the volume.
- 2.Hold down the volumekey on the headset to reduce the volume.
