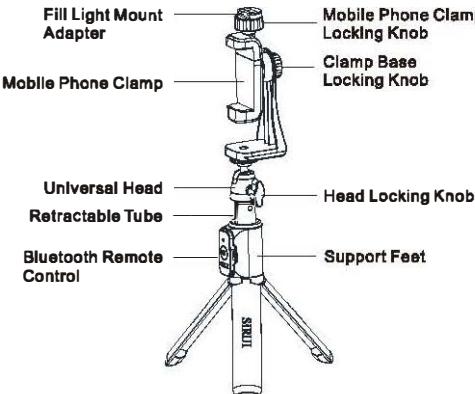

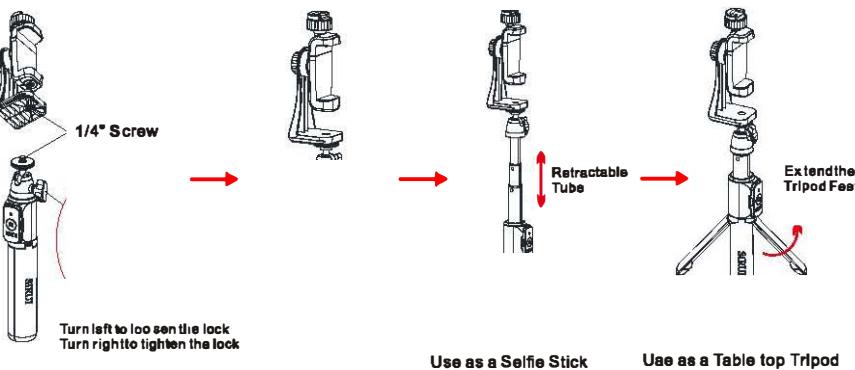

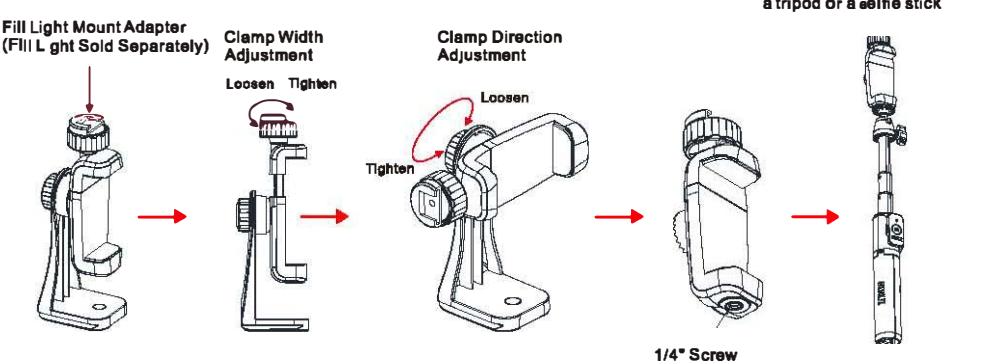

### 3. Use of Mobile Phone Clamp



#### 1 Know the Product (fig 1)

The Table-top Tripod is composed of a Support Feet, Mobile Phone Clamp, and a Bluetooth Remote Control.

#### 2. Use of Table-Top Tripod (fig.2)

The product can be used as a Selfie Stick or a Table-top Tripod. The height of it can be adjusted as desired.

#### 3. Use of Mobile Phone Clamp (fig.3)

The Clamp of product can hold a mobile phone with size within 4-6 inches. The mobile phone held on the Clamp can be adjusted for its direction by turning the locking knob behind the Clamp. The Clamp can be attached to a tripod or selfie stick.

#### 4. Use of Remote Control (fig 4)

a. Bluetooth Function: Press and hold the "Bluetooth" button for 4 seconds, when the indicator light of it is flashing, the Remote Control will enter the search mode for connecting device via bluetooth (bluetooth signal name: SiRui). The Indicator Light will be off after it's connected.

b. Shooting Function: Press the "Shoot" button for photography. Long press on the button is useless.

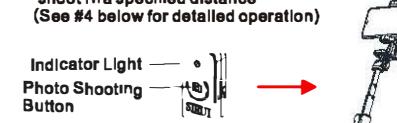
c. Sleep Mode: The Remote Control will enter the Sleep Mode when it's not operated within 5 minutes, or can not be connected with any device via bluetooth within 2 minutes.

d. Wake Mode: When the Remote Control is in the Sleep Mode, press the "Wake" button to re-connect to the last device automatically via bluetooth. When it's connected, the Indicator Light will flash once, otherwise it will enter the Sleep Mode again.

e. Low Power Indicator: When the button type battery in the Remote Control is in low power, the indicator will start to alarm, and the LED light will flash every 0.5 second, the Remote Control will turn off automatically after 10 seconds.

### 4. Use of Bluetooth Remote Control

a. Remote Control can be connected with mobile phone via bluetooth for remotely controlling your mobile camera to shoot in a specified distance (See #4 below for detailed operation)



#### b. Battery Installation or replacement



#### Caution:

Do not exceed the recommended load limit of the head and/or tripod. (Please refer to product specifications.)

Please make sure that the locks are securely tightened when in use.

This product should not be used in environments that exceed the following conditions (-40 ~ +100°C/-40 ~ +212°F). And, when used in damp, dirty or dusty environments, please clean and dry thoroughly after use to assure proper functioning in the future. It is not recommended to expose this product to saltwater. If exposed, please clean with mild soap and warm water and towel dry.

Please keep from high temperatures and direct exposure to bright sunlight for extended periods of time.

Please do not leave the equipment alone in a public place which can be an inconvenience or hazard to others.

To protect your camera gear please remove it from the tripod/bell head when transporting from place to place.

Please use a soft towel with warm water and mild soap to clean the locking system and gliding parts when necessary. Towel dry before storing the tripod.

Under most situations, there is no need to lubricate any parts of this product. The addition of most lubricants will gum up the mechanisms and reduce their normal gliding characteristics. Please call or email us if you have any questions or special needs.

Please keep this product away from all electrical power sources.
