## **Stay comfortable**


Please take a few breaks when using JIMO for the first time.

If you feel unwell, such as dizziness, motion sickness, nausea, confusion, headache, eye fatigue, etc., please stop using it immediately.






Nose pad is installed




Please align at the back of the leg



Ear hook is installed









### 1. Application List


Click the right arrow to bring up the list of installed apps



### 2. WiFi connection


- Open the "Setting" button on the right

### 3. Bluetooth connection


- Open the "Setting" button on the right

press the handle touchpad.


The selection and confirmation operations in the system can be completed.




## How to edit the window

Through the small icons in the status bar of the task window, the window can be zoomed in, zoomed out, zoomed in, zoomed out, fixed in full screen, and closed.


