
Staying comfortable

If you feel uncomfortable, such as dizziness, motion sickness, nausea, confusion, headache, eyestrain, please stop using it immediately.








Turn Action One On or Off

To turn off Action One , long press the power button for 2–4 seconds.


WEARING

support focus adjustment.





Rotate the headband up.





Turn the adjustment wheel to tighten the headband until it fits snugly.




Controller

Select and Confirm


To select a hologram, button or other elements, please aim the pointer at it and press the touchpad.



How to edit windows?

The SAR limit of USA (FCC) is 1.6 W/kg averaged over one gram of tissue. Device types: Mixed Reality HDM (FCC ID:2AQYUACTIONONE-A1) has also been tested against this SAR limit. The highest SAR value reported under this standard during product certification for use at the head is 0.306W/kg, This device was tested for head operations with the edge of the helmet kept 0mm from the head. To maintain compliance with FCC RF exposure requirements, use accessories that maintain a 0mm separation distance between the head and the edge of the helmet.
