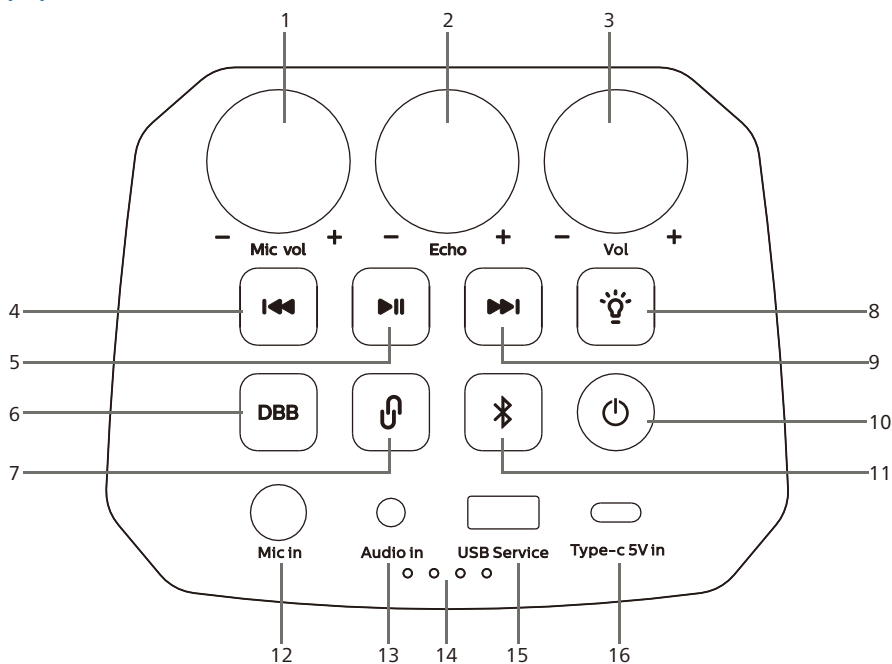

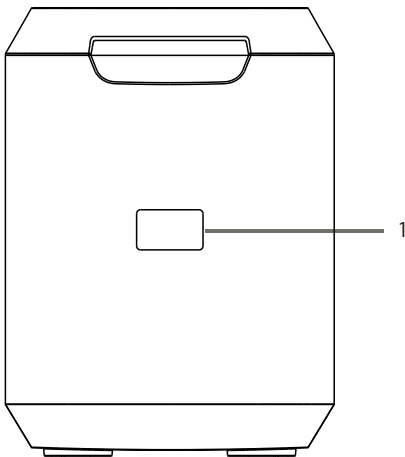

Power on

Press 

- ➔ Press and hold for 3 seconds to switch on/off the party speaker.

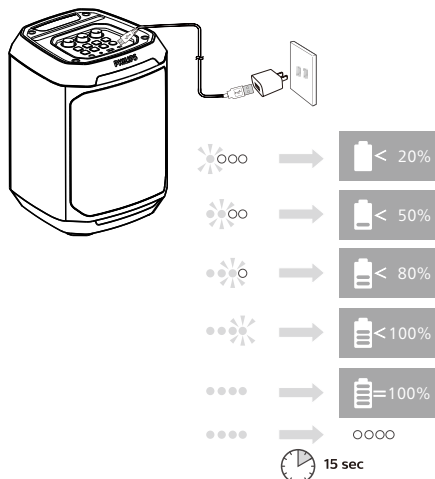

- The party speaker will always enter Bluetooth pairing mode every time you turn it on.

Charge the built-in battery

- Plug the USB cord to charge the built-in battery. The battery indicators blink in different manners to indicate the charging status.

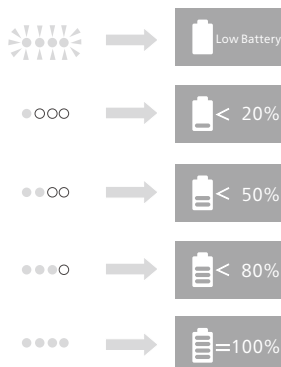
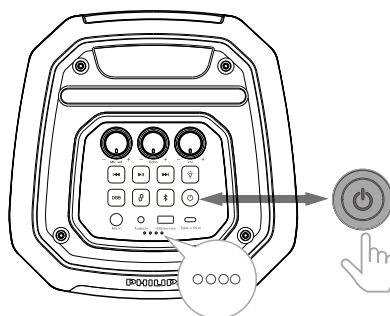
Note: The four indicators on the unit will go out in 15 seconds after the battery is fully charged.



- The speaker is designed with a smart battery check feature for your convenience.
- Press  button to show the current battery level on the LED indicators of the unit in power on mode while the unit is not being charged.

- 4 LED white light up=approx. 100% full
- 3 LED white light up=approx. 80% full
- 2 LED white light up=approx. 50% full
- 1 LED white light up=approx. 20% full (indicating charging is needed)

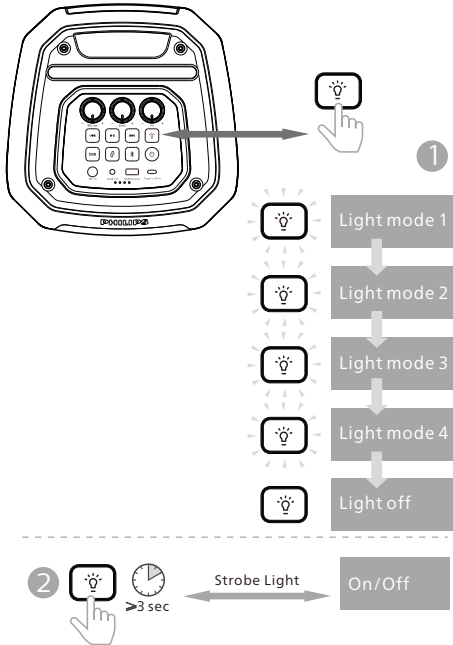

4 Change light effect

Turn decorative light on or off

1. In power on mode, press  (Light) button repeatedly to switch among different light modes of speaker light.
2. In power on mode, press and hold  (Light) button for 3 seconds to switch on/off the strobe light.



5 Play audio through Bluetooth

The product can stream music from your Bluetooth device to the system through Bluetooth.

Connect a device

Note

Connect a device automatically

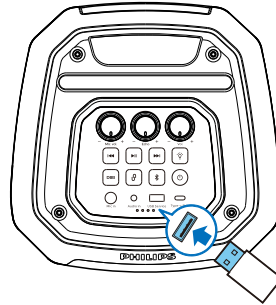

6 USB Service

The USB upgrade features

- 1 Insert the USB plug of the device into the USB slot.
- 2 Press and hold **⏻** button for 3 seconds to switch on the party speaker and then you will hear a prompt tone.



Control play

In USB mode, follow the instructions below to control play.

Button	Action
⏮ / ⏭	Press to skip to the previous or next track.
⏸	Press to pause or resume play.

Adjust volume

During play, press **+/-** button on the party speaker to increase or decrease volume.

The green speaker light will change accordingly to indicate the volume adjustment.

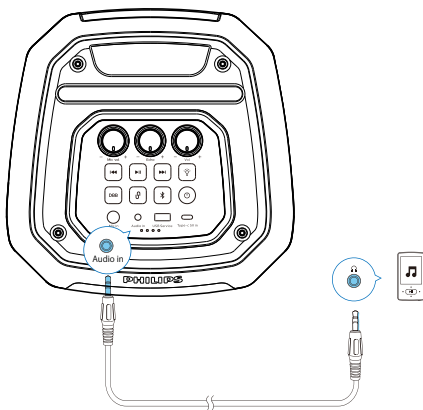

Listen to an external device

With this product, you can listen to an external audio device such as an MP3 player.

Play from an MP3 player

- 1 Press and hold  button for 3 seconds to switch on the party speaker and then you will hear a prompt tone.
- 2 Connect an audio input cable (not supplied) with a 3.5mm connector on both ends to:
 - The **Audio in** jack on the product.
 - The headphone jack on the MP3 player.
- 3 The blue backlight  button will go off and the party speaker will be automatically switched to Line in source.
- 4 Play audio on the MP3 player (refer to its user manual).



8 Sing through microphone

Adjust microphone volume

Connect a microphone(not supplied) into the Mic in jack of the unit, and adjust the microphone volume by turning the **Mic vol** knob.

Now, enjoy the karaoke singing!

Adjust echo

Adjust the microphone echo level to your desired level by turning the **Echo** knob on the top panel.

- You need to re-insert the audio input cable into the **Audio in** jack if you want to switch back to Line in from the other sources.

9 TWS pair button

Pairing for stereo mode (TWS)

Two speakers can pair with each other for stereo sound.

 Note

- TWS is worked only if there are two identical party speakers(philips TAX2208)

Select master speaker manually

- 1 Press and hold  key for 3 seconds to power on both speakers and enter to bluetooth pairing mode.
 - ↳ The LED indicator(LED3) on both speakers blink blue.
- 2 Select one speaker as master and connect to Bluetooth.
 - ↳ LED3 on master speaker turns solid blue once Bluetooth is connected.
- 3 Press and hold  (TWS) button on both speakers for 3seconds to enter stereo pairing mode(TWS).
 - ↳ LED3 blinks blue and white alternatively on both speakers.
- 4 When TWS is connected, you will hear a voice prompt.
 - ↳ LED3 turns solid blue on both speakers.
- 5 To exit TWS, press and hold  (TWS) button on either speaker.

Select master speaker automatically

- 1 Press and hold  touch key for 3 seconds to power on both speakers.
 - ↳ The LED indicator(LED3) on both speakers blink blue.
- 2 Press and hold  TWS button on both speakers for 3 seconds to enter stereo pairing mode.

- ↳ The first speaker entered TWS node is master and LED3 on master speaker turns sold blue.
- ↳ The volume level, play/pause state, light mode in slave speaker will sync from master speaker after TWS connected.

- 3 To exit TWS, press and hold  (TWS) button on either speaker.

- During TWS pairing mode, both master and slave speaker will return to previous state automatically after 1 minute without user operations or TWS pairing is not successful.
