

User Manual for LED Mirror

User Guide For LED And Bluetooth

- 1. Connect the power socket on the back of the mirror with the power cord. Turn on the power switch, then you will hear a voice "Bluetooth Mode".
- 2. Press the light switch to turn on the led lights. The lights can be 3 colors ---- yellow, warm white, white. Quickly press the light switch twice to change the color. Keep pressing the light switch to adjust the brightness.
- 3.Keep pressing the time switch to set the hour time and minute time. Quick press the time switch to change the number.
- 4. Turn on the Bluetooth on your phone, then search 'A3' and connect it. If successfully, you will hear a clear voice. Turn on the music player on your phone to play music. Music volume can be adjusted with your phone.
- 5. A USB port on the bottom of the mirror can be used for charging your phone. An extra socket on the back of the mirror can be used for connecting electrical tools, such as hair dryer.
- 6. After use, please turn off the power switch.

Caution

- 1. This product is applicable to rated voltage 110-250V, maximum wattage is 500W.
- 2. Please unplug hair dryer or other high-power electrical appliance immediately after use so that possible accident as a result of overheat and long time working caused by forgotten carelessness can be avoided.
- 3. In case of smoke or fire, please don't pull the plug with hand if the cause of smoke or fire is unidentified. Power supply must be cut off by using insulator to unplug the product and then ask professional technician for help.
