



Device Overview

Open Power-Off/Screen-Off




- Power-On: When the device is off, press and hold the power button for 3 seconds to turn it on.
- Power-Off: When the device is on, press and hold the power button for 3 seconds and select Power Off in the shutdown menu that appears.
- Screen-Off: When the device is on, press the power button to turn off the screen display.

⊙ Vertical/Horizontal

1. Vertical Touch Control Projection:


Stand the device upright on a flat surface. After turning it on, you can perform touch control operations in the projection area.



* Do not place objects in the projection area and avoid strong light sources that shine on the projection area.

2. Horizontal Cinema Projection:

Lay the device horizontally on a flat surface. After turning it on, you can project a large cinema-style screen on a wall or projection screen. To enlarge or reduce the projection area, adjust the distance between the wall or screen and the device



^{*} Do not place objects in the projection path or projection area and avoid strong light sources that shine on the projection area.

When the device is in the horizontal position, it is better to operate it using the remote control.

Autofocusing

After the device turns on, it will take around 4 seconds to autofocus the picture. To readjust the focus, tilt the device forward about 30° and stand it up straight again.

Wireless Projection

When the device is connected to the same Wi-Fi as your mobile phone or tablet, enable the wireless projection mode, such as AirPlay, on your device. In the list of available devices, connect to the one that includes the words "puppy cube" in its name.

Hard Reset (Fault Recovery)

If the device keeps crashing, freezing, or does not work properly, press and hold the power button for 15 seconds to force restart the device.

If the force restart operation has no effect, insert a pin or some other long and thin object into the RESET hole to force shut down the de vice. After the device shuts down, press the power button for 3 seconds to restart the device.



Remote Control State	Operational State	Indicator State
Pairing	Press and hold the Back and Menu buttons for 3 seconds	Blue and red light flashes for 60 seconds
Paired	Any button is pressed	Blue light flashes once
Charging	Charging	Red light remains on
	Fully charged	Green light remains on
Low battery	Any button is pressed	Red light flashes twice

Precautions

- Do not point the projector at eyes, as it may cause injury.
