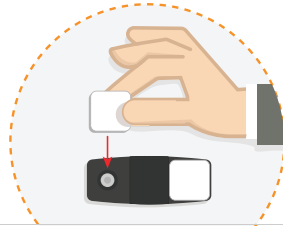


1 Power Device On



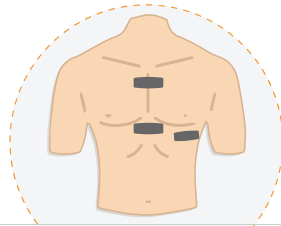
Locate the power icon and press firmly.

2 Place Adhesives



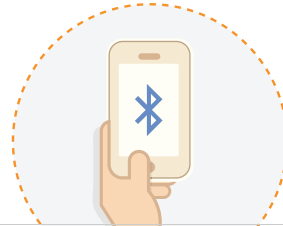
Snap adhesives into device.
Peel backing away and discard.

3 Position Device



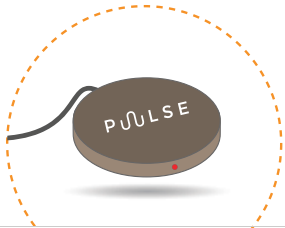
Position device as shown.

4 Pair with App



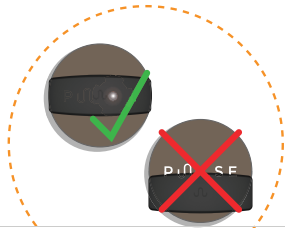
Download Puulse app and open.
