

# Innway tracker

## USER GUIDE



## Step 1:

please download App “Innway tracker” from App store or Google Play.Or scan the QR code to download.



## Compatible devices:

For IOS: iPhone 4S and later

For Android: android TM 4.4 and above.

## Step 2:

Turn on Bluetooth.

Make sure your phone Bluetooth is on.

## Step 3:

Sign up for New user.

Start "innway tracker"App and tap the "sign up".

## Step 4:

Pair the innway device to your phone.

- 1). Make sure to turn on your phone's Bluetooth.
- 2). Hold the innway device close to your phone.
- 3). Hold the button on the innway until you hear a beep and the led starts flashing.

## Attach:

Innway card to anything you don't want to lose. Connect it to the Innway app.

## Ring:

When the device and phone are connected. you can use the device to find your phone, or use your phone to find the device.

## Motion History:

Your missing items. The app remembers when and where you last had them.

## Camera Remote:

The button on the card also acts as a camera remote. Never be left out of a group picture again.

## Rechargeable battery:

Battery life up to 2 Months and the battery percent also display in APP and could rechargeable.
