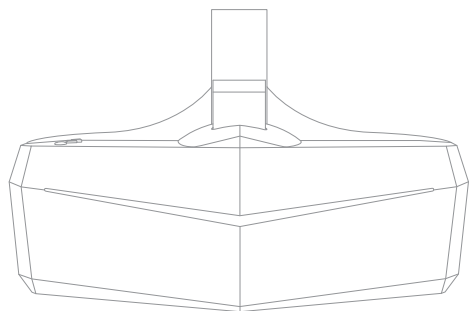

Step 2, Connect Pimax 8K to PC

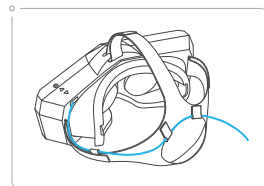

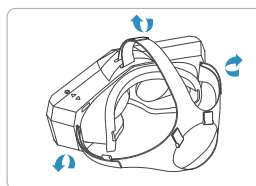

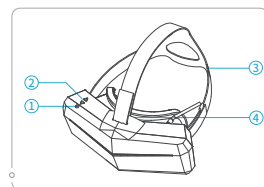
Data cable assembly



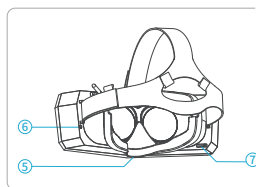
Bands assembly

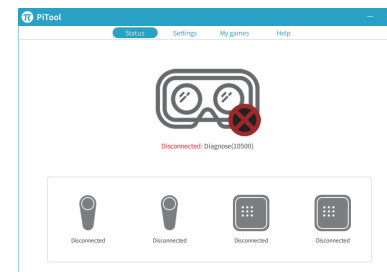

3.The software installation and instructions

3.1 Install Pi Tool software

Download Pi Tool from www.pimaxvr.com and install

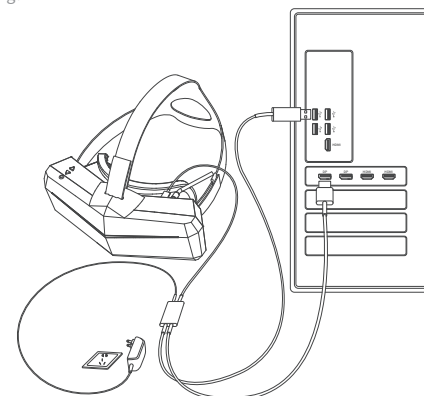


3.2 Connect to computer

Recommended configuration:

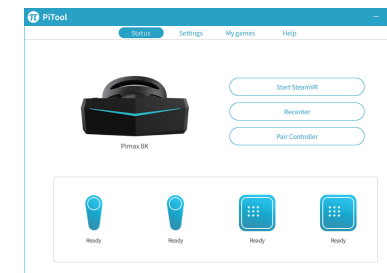
OS:	Windows 7 SP1/Windows 10 64bit or later
CPU:	Intel Core i5 or equivalent or later
GPU:	NVIDIA GTX1070 or later
Ram:	8GB or bigger
Output:	DP1.4, USB2.0/3.0

Cabling:



Check whether Pimax 8K VR is connected to PC correctly.

If you see the Pi Tool interface, it means the VR is connected to PC correctly and recognized by Pi Tool.



4. Shut down and power off

4.1 Shut down

During using the VR, long press power key, The VR will be shut down and enter standby mode.

4.2 Power off

Pull out the USB plug to cut off the power supply to VR.

5. Firmware Updating

Open Pi Tool when the internet access is available. Pi Tool will check the firmware version, and remind you if the firmware need to be updated.

Attention: Please DO NOT disconnect your USB cable or close your PC when you are updating the firmware.
