





Plug in Genki


Initiate pairing on headphone.

THINGS TO KNOW

- When Genki is connected it will attempt to auto-connect to both sides until one paired audio device connects.
- Each button is independent and can be connected to its own device allowing you to stream audio to two devices.
- Only one device can be paired to each button at any given time, a new pairing will erase the previous pairing.
- Many angles of the Portable Stand give enough clearance for charging.
- Connect Genki Audio to the Dock Adapter and you can use it any of the dock's USB ports.
- The Mini Boom microphone works with games with built-in voice chat and must be plugged in before Genki.
- LED indicators auto dim five seconds after connecting to be less distracting.

The product has two USB ports, USB1 is connected to the gamepad for data transmission,
USB2 connects to the charging port and supplies power to the handle through USB1
