## UNIVERSAL Operation

### Charging USB Devices from Battery

1. Plug device into UNIVERSAL with USB cable
2. Device will begin charging automatically
3. LCD will display current battery level while charging

### Charging Wireless Devices from Battery

1. Press the power button on UNIVERSAL.
2. Place phone on UNIVERSAL wireless logo
3. LED will be red and LCD will display current battery level while charging

*If inserting or removing USB during wireless charging, press the power button to continue wireless charging.*

### Recharging Internal Battery with Wall Outlet

1. Plug UNIVERSAL into wall power outlet
2. LED will blink indicating current battery level
3. USB and wireless can charge devices simultaneously

### Recharging Internal Battery by USB Type-C

1. Plug USB Type-C cable into UNIVERSAL
2. Plug cable into wall or computer USB port
3. LED will blink indicating current battery level

### Changing Travel Adapters

1. Firmly grab sides of adapter
2. Pull straight out
3. Reverse direction when inserting new adapter.
