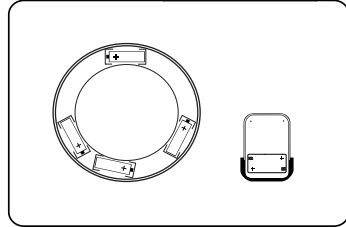
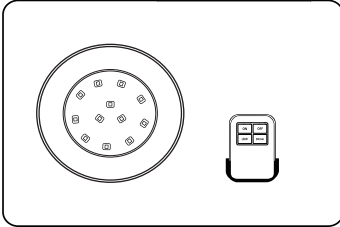
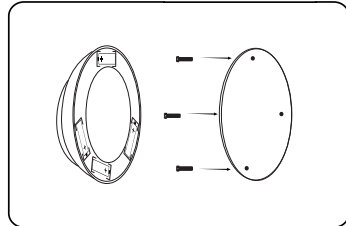
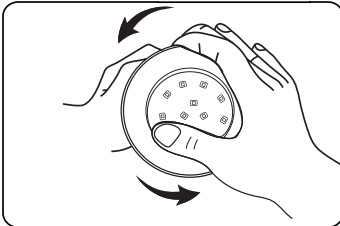


# CEILING/WALL LIGHT WITH REMOTE(YS002)

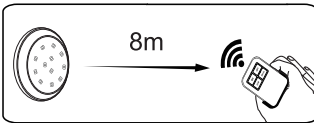
## INSTRUCTION



- 01 Insert batteries in the back of the light and remote as shown. Insert 4x"AA" batteries.

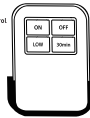


- 02 Twist the back cover of the light counter clockwise open. Mount the back plate to a wall or ceiling(screws included).



• Press the 'On' button on the remote control to activate LEDs at full brightness.

• Press the 'Low' button on the remote control to dim the LEDs



• Press the 'Off' button on the remote control to turn off the LEDs

• Press the '30 min' button on the remote control to activate the 30 minute timer

- 03 The remote distance approximately 8 meters.

Size:L=17cm,W=17cm,TH=2.5cm(Lamp)  
L=9.5cm,W=7.0cm,TH=2.5cm(Remote)  
Material: ABS, 12 White LEDs.  
AA batteries **NOT** included. 4 pcs for each lamp.  
2pcs for remote.
