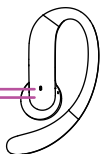

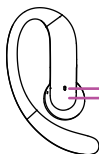

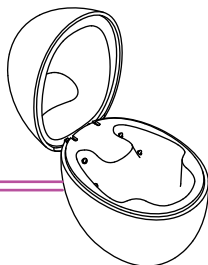

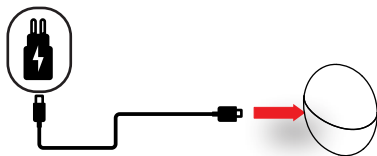


Charging the Earphones

Place the earphones in the charging case in order to charge.

Charging the Case

Insert the included charging cable's USB-C end into the USB-C charging port on the case. Insert the other end into a USB port on a computer or a suitable wall adapter. Leave to charge.

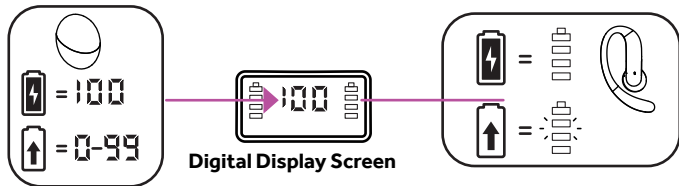


Charging Status

The digits on the case's digital display screen will increase from 0-100 as the case charges and will display a solid '100%' once the case is fully charged.

The earphone battery icons on the digital display screen will show each earphone's charging status as they are charging inside the charging case. The right earphone battery icon will flash while the right earphone charges, and the left earphone battery icon will flash while the left earphone charges.

In addition, an LED light on each earphone will turn red as the earphone charges and turn off once the earphone is fully charged.

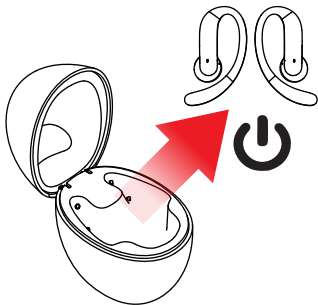


POWERING ON/OFF

When first using your earphones place them into the case. Remove them from the case and they will automatically turn ON. Place them back into the case and they will automatically turn off.

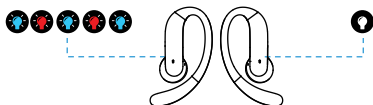
Notes:

1. If the earphones are out of the charging case, put them into the case and take out again to turn ON.
2. You can also manually power your earphones on or off by pressing and holding the touch control area on each earphone for three to five seconds.



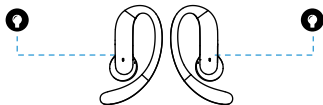
BLUETOOTH PAIRING

Remove your earphones from the case and they will power ON. After a few moments they will pair with each other and then go into Bluetooth pairing mode. When your earphones are in Bluetooth pairing mode, an LED indicator light on one earphone will flash red and blue and the indicator of other earphone will turn off.



Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone. Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as "SRVRA1000."

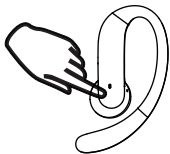
The LED indicator light on both earphones will turn off once paired to your phone.



After setting up Bluetooth, the earphones will automatically re-connect to the device every time you take them out of the charging case.

If your earphones remain unpaired with a Bluetooth device, they will automatically power off after approximately five minutes.

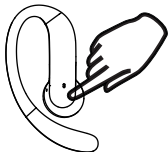


LEFT EARPHONE

Play/Pause: Press
Next Track: Double Press
Increase Volume: Triple Press
Voice Assistant: Press and hold for ~2 seconds
Answer Call: Press
End Call: Press
Decline Call: Press and hold for ~2 seconds
Power ON/OFF: Press and hold for 3-5 seconds

RIGHT EARPHONE

Play/Pause: Press
Previous Track: Double Press
Decrease Volume: Triple Press
Voice Assistant: Press and hold for ~2 seconds
Answer Call: Press
End Call: Press
Decline Call: Press and hold for ~2 seconds
Power ON/OFF: Press and hold for 3-5 seconds

RESETTING YOUR EARPHONES

If you are experiencing issues that cannot be resolved by simply turning the earphones on and off or by placing them back into the case you may have success by doing a manual reset.

1. Power off your Bluetooth device, and power off your earphones by placing them in the charging case.
2. Take one earphone from the charging case. The indicator light flashes red and blue alternately. Press the touch control four times quickly to turn off the earbud. Then, do the same with the other earbud.

Maintenance and Care

- Use a soft cloth or paper towel to clean your earphones. Never use any harsh chemicals or detergents for cleaning. Make sure your earphones are dry before charging.
- When your earphones are not in use, they should be stored in a cool, dry place.
- Never tug or yank on a cable while it is connected to your charging case. Connect and disconnect cables as carefully as possible.
- Never expose your earphones to high temperatures, extreme cold.
