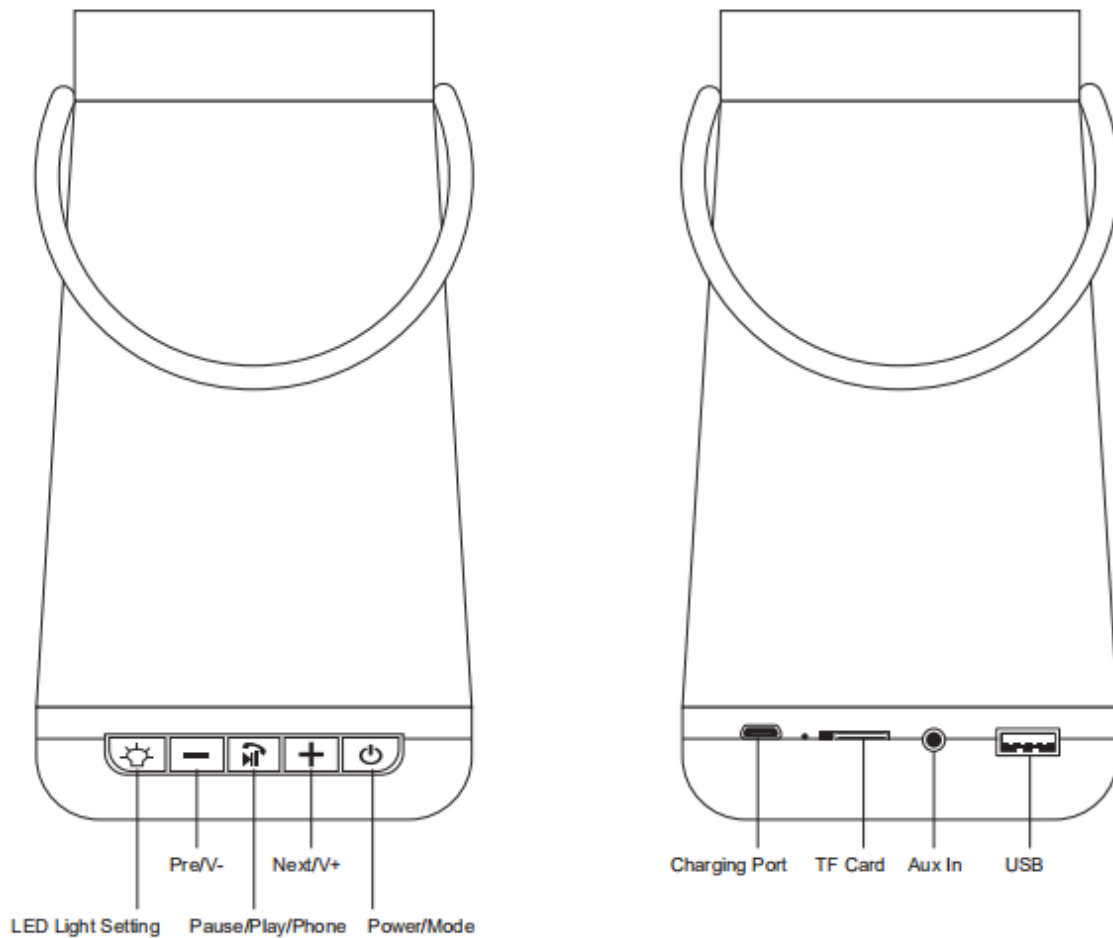

BLUETOOTH LIGHT UP SPEAKER



Thanks for your purchase of our Bluetooth Speaker!

Like all our products, great care has been taken in its design. A combination of advanced engineering and state-of-the-art materials will provide you with years of listening pleasure.

Charging the Battery

- Before using, fully charge the battery by using the supplied USB charging cable.
- Insert DC plug of the charging cable into the DC 5V power jack on the unit.
- Insert USB connector into USB port on supplying power (Laptop, Computer, AC Charger, Car Charger, etc.).
- The LED indicator turns red when the battery is being charged.
- When the battery is fully charged, the red LED indicator will be go out.

Power on/off

- Long press the “**Power**” button to turn on/off the unit.

Bluetooth Pairing

- When the devices turn on and there are no external devices such as a TF Card, an AUX Cable or USB; The Bluetooth Speaker enter into **Bluetooth Mode** and have prompt tone “The devices is ready to paring”.
- Open the Bluetooth® settings on your phone, tablet or other Bluetooth enabled audio device, make sure Bluetooth is on and search for “**VTA-82457**”. Once found, click on it. You may be required to enter a password. If so, please enter **0000**.

- Once paired, will have prompt tone “the devices is connected successfully”.

Playing Music

- Select a song, artist, genre, or playlist on your phone, tablet or other Bluetooth enabled audio device.
- Short press the “**play/pause**” button to start or pause the music.
- Short press the “**Pre/V-**” or “**Next/V+**” button to go to last /next song.
- Long press the “**Pre/V-**” or “**Next/V+**” button to adjust volume.

Hands-free For Calling

- Pick up or hang up a call by short pressing the “**Phone**” button.
- Press and hold the “**Phone**” Button to reject when a new call comes in.
- Press the “**Phone**” Button twice to redial the last phone call.

AUX./USB Flash/TF playing

- Play music directly when insert in TF card and USB flash.
Long press the “**Mode**” button to switch between Bluetooth/Radio/AUX/TF card/USB Drive

FM Mode

- Short press “**Mode**” button to enter Radio Mode. Plug in the Micro USB Cable to use the speaker 's radio. The USB Cable functions as an antenna.
- Short press “**Play/Pause**” button, the radio will search channels automatically. Channels will be stored after auto search ends.

RGB Light

- Short press “**LED Light setting**” button to choose your favorite light mode(10kinds)
