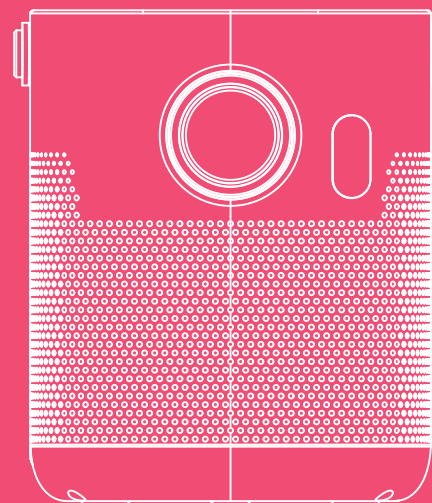

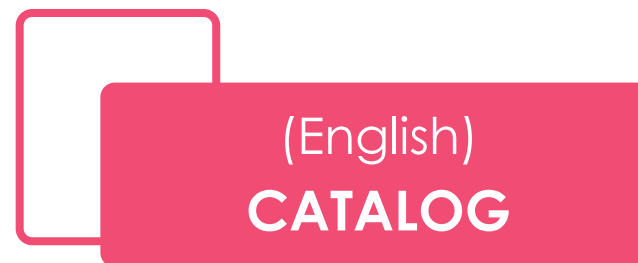

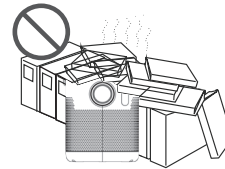
## Safety Instructions

Read all instructions before you use this device. Do not make any changes or create settings that are not described in this manual. If physical injury, loss of data or damage is caused by failure to follow instructions, the warranty does not apply.

### Setup

1. To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not expose the device to rain or moisture. Objects filled with liquids, such as vases, should not be placed on this device.
2. Do not place this device on soft surfaces such as tablecloths or carpets, otherwise the device could be a fire hazard.
3. Do not place this device in areas susceptible to excessive dust and dirt or near any appliance generating a strong magnetic field.
4. To prevent overheating, do not block or clog the ventilation openings.
5. Never place this device in a confined space. Leave enough space around this device for ventilation.
6. Protect this device from overexposure to direct sunlight, heat, large temperature fluctuations and moisture. Avoid extreme temperatures. The suitable operations and storage temperature for this device and its accessories is (0°F to 95°F).
7. When this device is running for a long period of time, the surface may become hot. Shut it down immediately and unplug the charger. Resume operation after this device has cooled down.
8. Always handle this device with care. Avoid touching the lens. Do not allow children to handle the device without supervision.

12. Avoid extreme vibrations as they may damage the internal components.

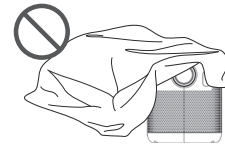
The following safety instructions ensure the long service life of the projector to avoid fire or electric shock. Please read carefully and pay attention to the following warnings.

Don't install the projector in hot and humid sites.



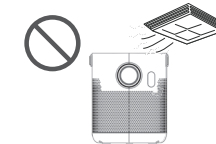
Don't cover the projector ventilation holes with any material.



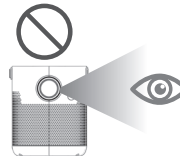
Don't install the projector in dust and smoke sites.

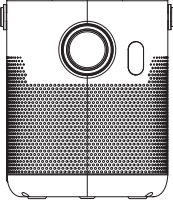
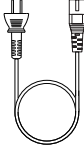
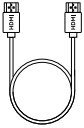
### Disposal

#### 1. Blurry Image

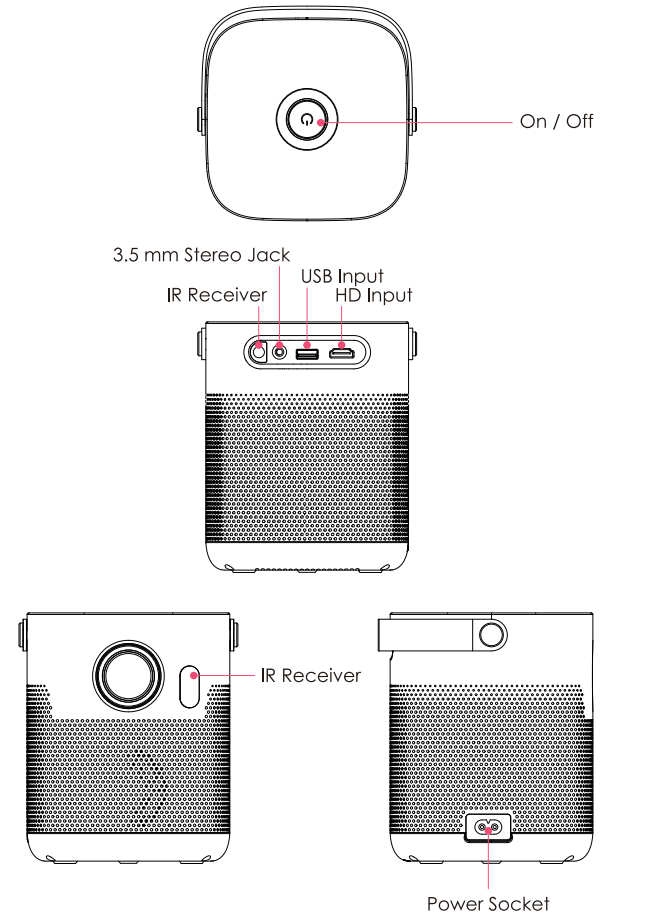
\* Go to setting - Display - Turn on the Auto Four - Corners Correction or enter Manual Keystone to adjust the image.

#### 2. Mounting Hole

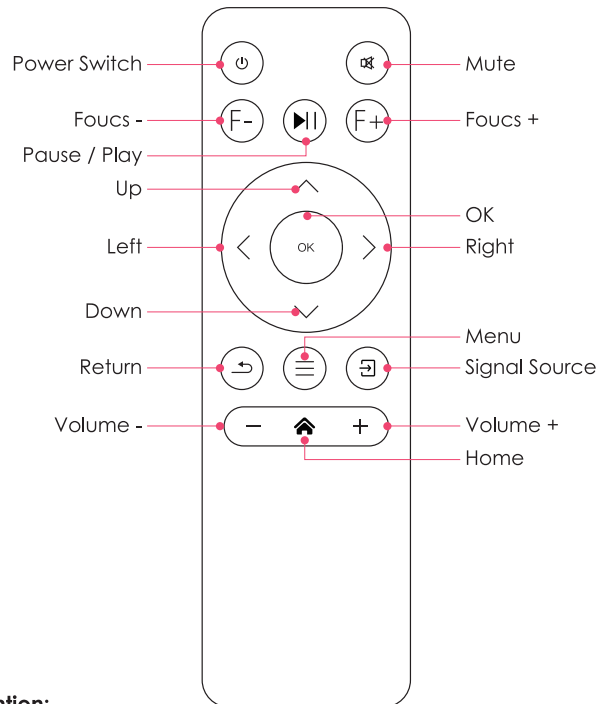
Adopting a single mounting hole dual-use design, the projector is compatible with the standard camera tripod and 1/4 inch screw projector tripod stand.

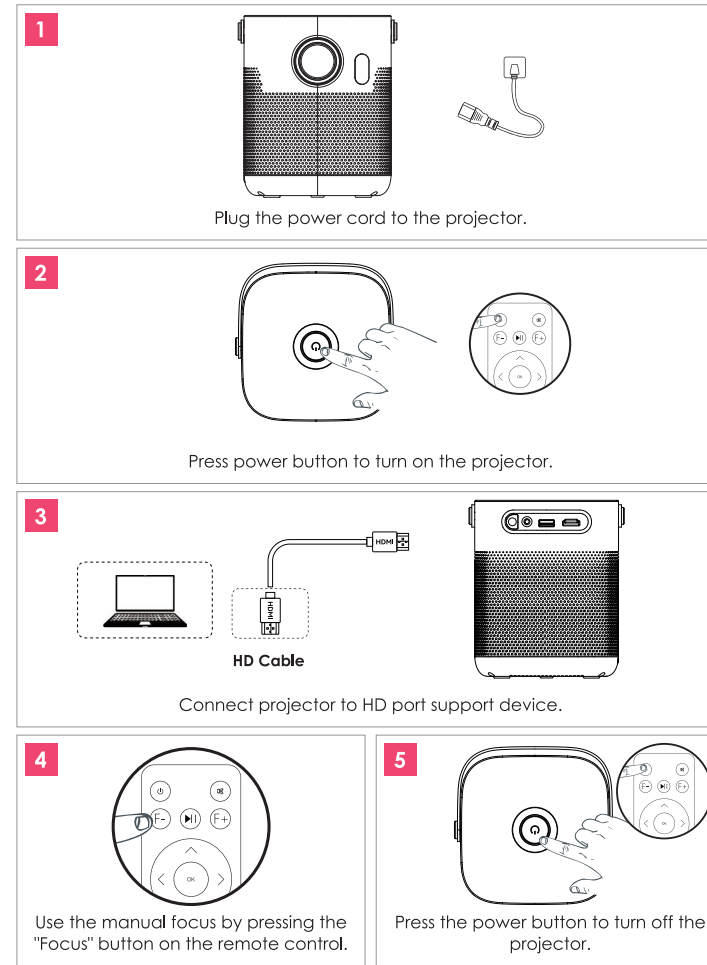
## Remote Control



### Attention:

1. Do not submerge the remote control in water.

5. Please point the remote control toward the IR receiver.
6. Please use the remote control within 6 meters distance and 30 degree angle.

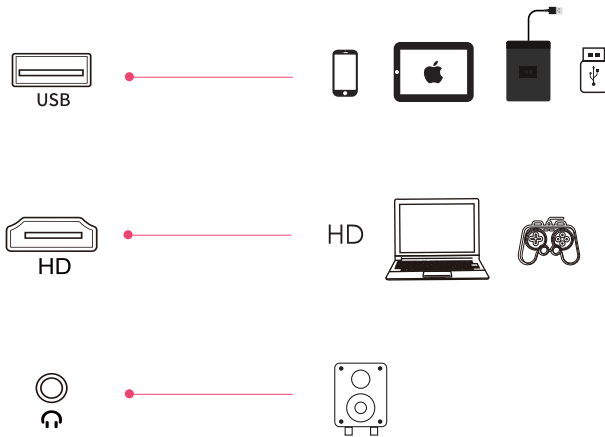

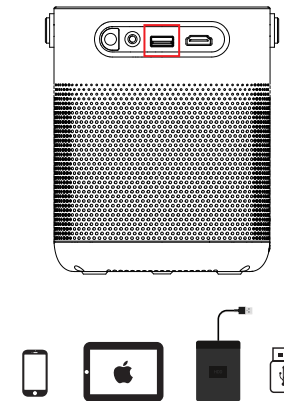

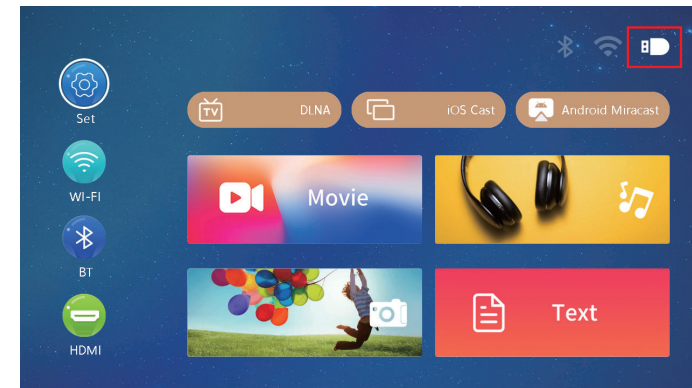
### • USB connection

**a. Insert the USB flash/storage hard drive into the USB port and choose USB as source from the menu.**

(The USB icon on the main interface will turn blue after the USB is inserted. If the USB icon on the interface does not display blue, you need to insert it again or check whether the USB disk is faulty.)

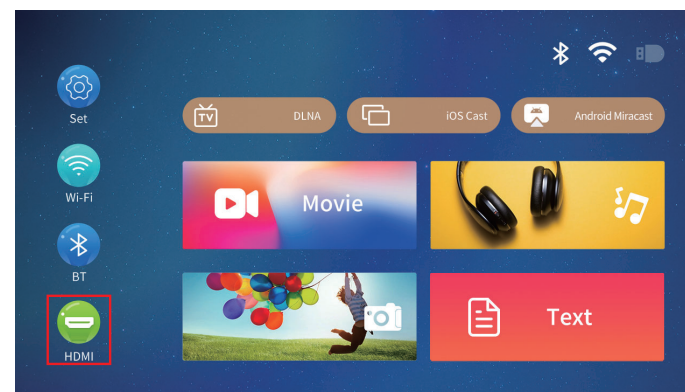
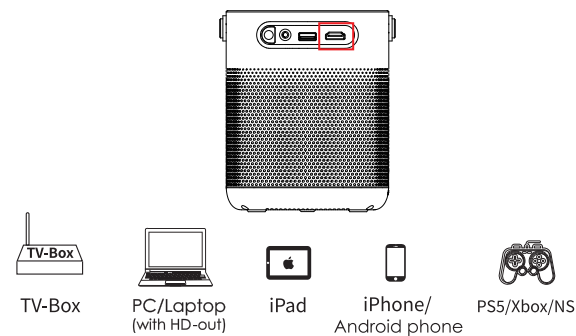

Once connected, select the HD signal source.

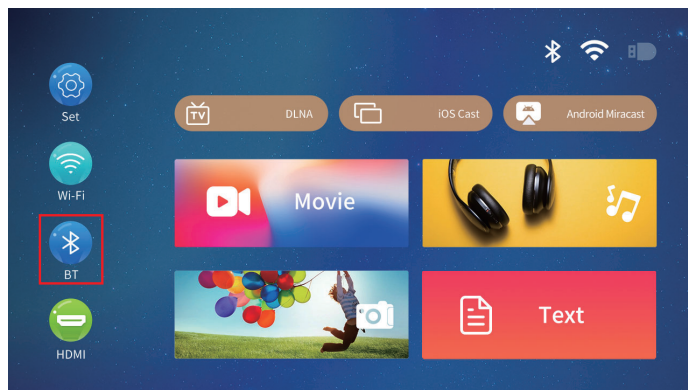


## Tips:

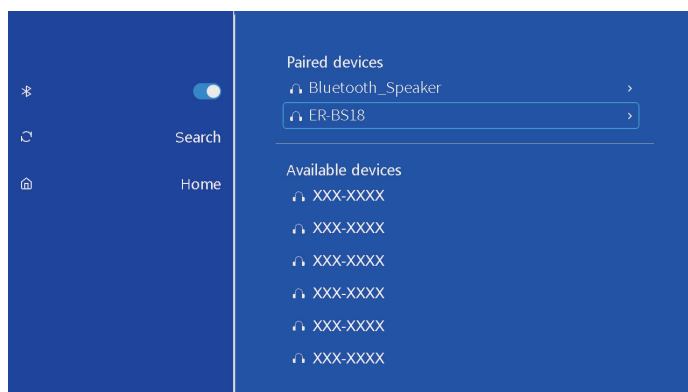
### • BT connection

b. Press **"OK"** key to turn BT on.

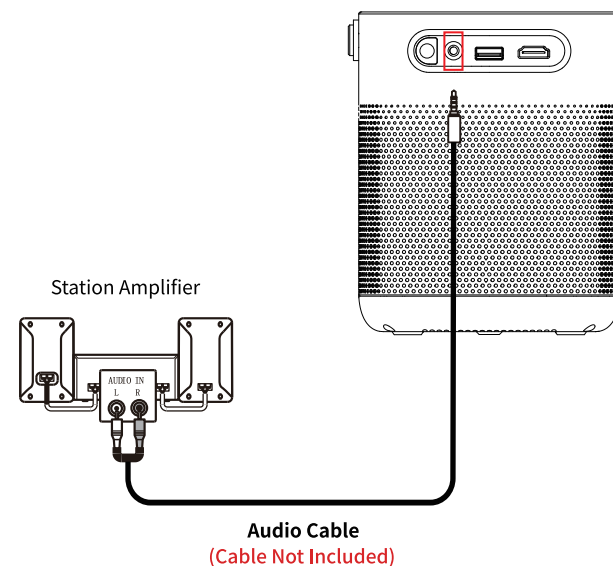
c. Select **"Scan for devices"** and press **"OK"** key to scan nearby BT speakers.

a. Use a 3.5mm audio jack to connect headphones and speaker equipment.



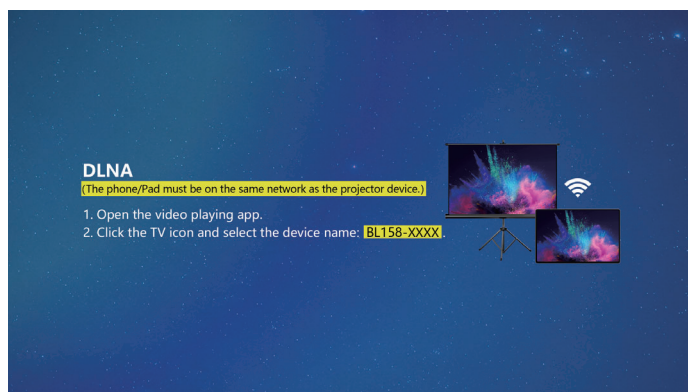
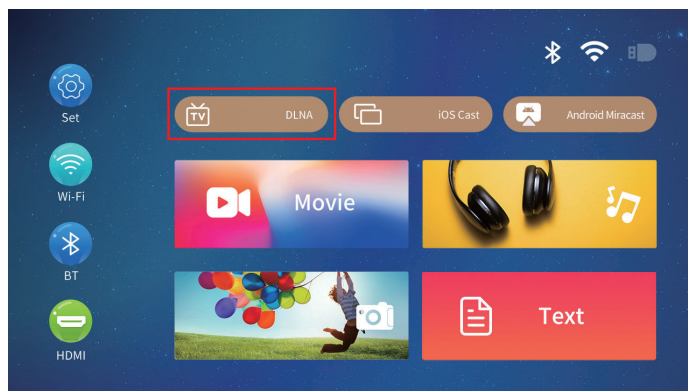
## • WiFi wireless screen mirroring

**Step 2.** Open the video playing app.

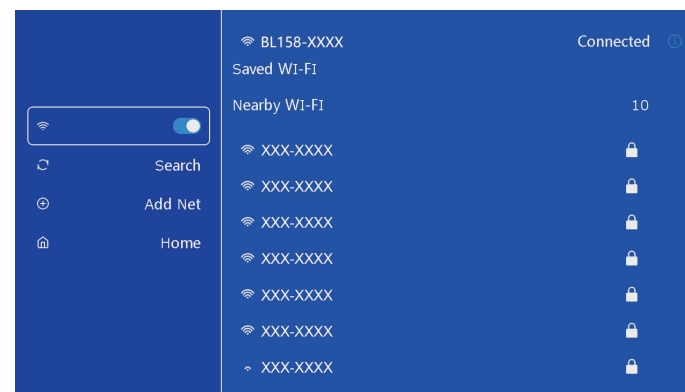
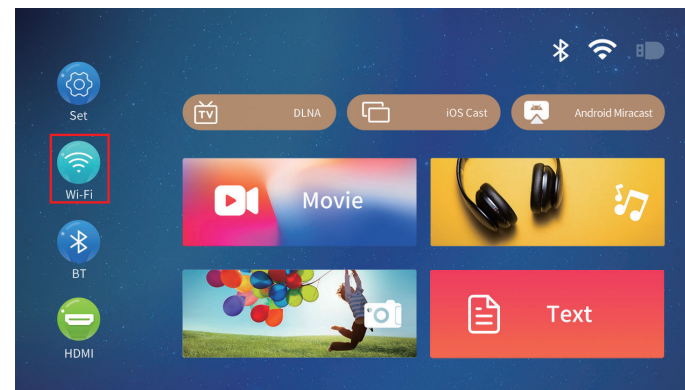
**Step 3.** Click the TV icon and select the device name: BL158-XXXX.



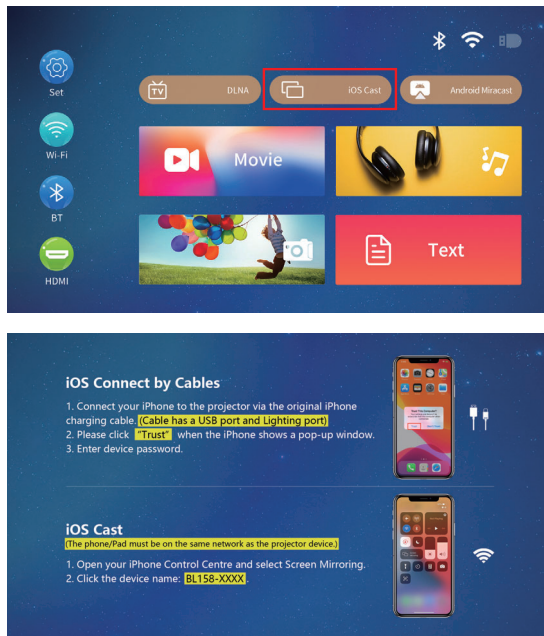
### b. For iPhone/iPad/iPod touch (iOS system)

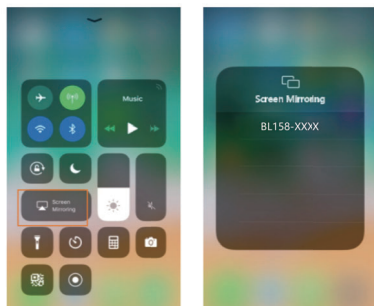
**Step 1.** Turn on the projector and select "WiFi". Setting up your WiFi.



**Step 2.** Go to the **"iOS Cast"**.



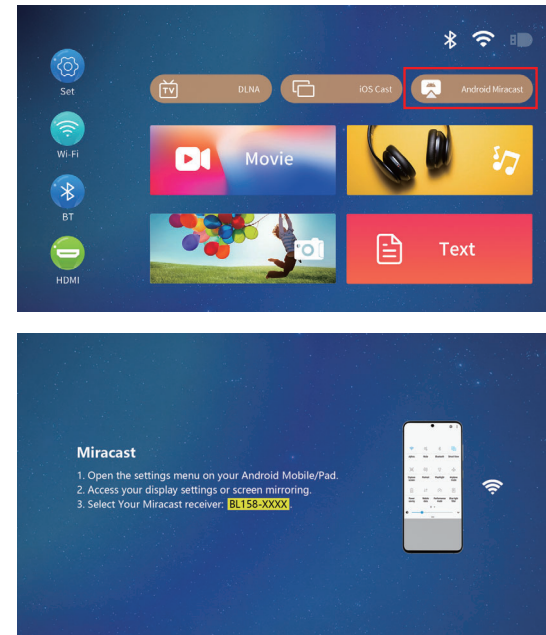

### c. Wireless connection to Android system

**To use this function, your Android device must support the Multi-screen/Wireless display.**

**Step 1.** Turn on the projector and select **"Miracast"**.



**Step 2.** Go to the Android device **"WIFI"** and select your WLAN.

**Step 3.** Activate Multi-screen function in your Android device and search for the projector, select **"BL158-XXXX"** and click to connect. Your Android device display will be projected to the wall/screen after a successful connection.

#### **Please note:**

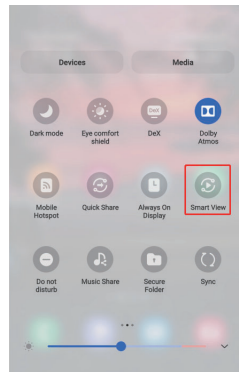
1. Make sure your mobile device is within 3 ft distance from the projector when using wireless connection.
2. Some mobile devices do not support screen mirroring.

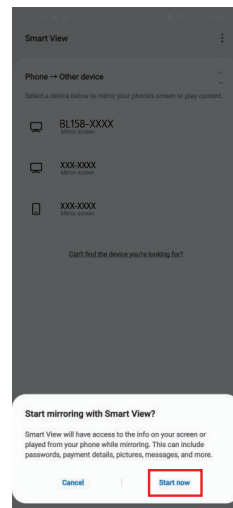

Step 2. Go to the phone "Settings" and open your Wi-Fi.



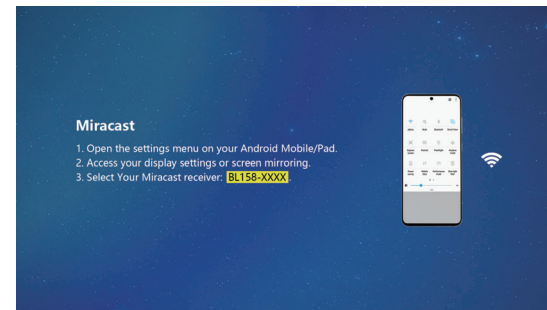
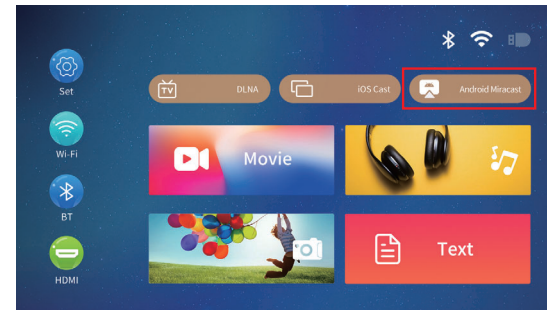
Step 3. Open the "Smart View" on your device, select "BL158-XXXX" and click to connect.

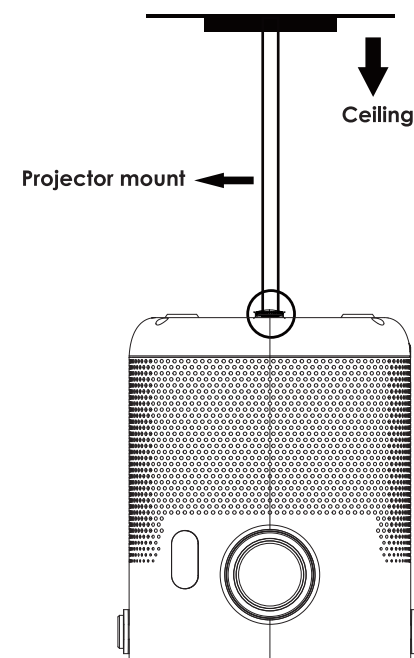

## Projector Installation

### Place your projector on the ceiling

1. When installing the projector on the ceiling, please purchase a projector bracket recommended by an installation professional and follow the instructions supplied with the bracket.
2. Before installing the projector on the ceiling, please check if the mounting structure can support the weight of the projector and the bracket. If in doubt please consult the advice of an installation.



Fixed Hanger Screw Hole Type: 1/4 inch.

**NOTE: Projector bracket and screw (s) are not included.**

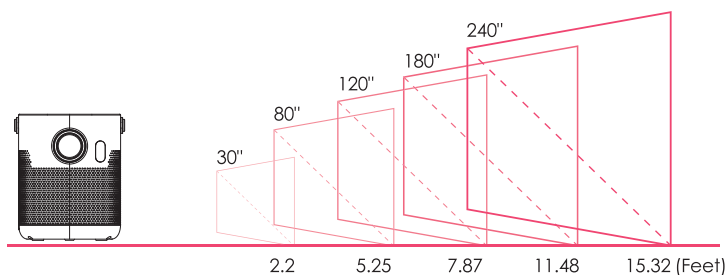

**NOTE:** Because the optical device has about 3% error, the above data is for reference only, please install the projector according to the actual measurement.

## Questions&Answers

\* Problems listed below might occur during the operation of your projector. Please refer to the possible factors which might cause the issue to do trouble-shooting.

**[Audio]Q: Why is the audio of the projector available but no display?**

**A1:** The video format is not supported by the projector.

**A2:** Encryption applied to the videos or media player which holds the video.

**A3:** If the lamp of the projector is off with only audio playing, the lamp is defective.

**A4:** Try another HD cable if you select the HD input source.

**A5:** Try YouTube if your screen mirroring player is Netflix, Amazon Prime, Hulu or Disney+. The problem will happens when playing these applications because of copyright.

**[Mounting]Q: What kind of screws do I need for mounting this projector?**

**A1:** 1/4 inch.

**[Image]Q: What can I do if the image is blurry?**

**A1:** Press the focus button of the remote control.

**A2:** Place the projector on a flat surface horizontally or vertically.

An inclination at any angle may result in blurry displays or uneven colors.

**A3:** Darker environment suggested achieving the best projection performance.

**A4:** The eligible distance between the projector and projecting screen/wall is 1.2-3.2 meters.

**A5:** Projecting wall or screen is clean white if possible.

**[Image]Q: How can I do if the image is up side down?**

**A1:** Enter Setting - Display - Projection Mode to rotate the image.

**[Image]Q: How can I do if the projection screen is not square or allied horizontally?**

**A1:** If the projection screen is not square, you could enter Setting - Display -Manual Keystone to adjust the image.

**A2:** Make sure the projector is placed on a flat surface with a projector light in the middle of the screen.

**A3:** Make sure the projector screen is placed horizontally.

**[Image]Q: How can I do if there is color distortion?**

**A1:** Make sure the video source has a fine resolution.

**A2:** Reset the projector to manufacturer setting: enter Setting-System - Factory Reset to reset.

**[Image]Q: How can I do if there is line/blurry screen in the projection picture?**

**A1:** Please restart it to see if it can be solved. The line/blurry screen is caused by the motherboard or screen.

**[Remote Control]Q: How can I do when the remote is unresponsive?**

**A1:** Make sure the batteries are installed correctly and the power is enough.

**A2:** Please make sure the IR receiver is not covered.

**[Setting]Q: How can I change the language?**

**A1:** Enter Setting-System-Language to select your language.

**[Damage]Q: How should I do if there is expanding dark spot or smoke when using the projector?**

**A1:** Check if the fan noise increases or the fan stops working.

**A2:** Make sure the outlet and projector power adapter are not wet or humid which will cause sparks or smoke on outlet when power on the projector.

**[Shut Off]Q: Why does the projector shut off during playing?**

**A1:** Make sure the power plug is working and firmly fitted into the outlet.

**A2:** Overheat the projector will activate the built-in power-off protection panel.

Restart the projector when it gets cooler.

**[USB]Q: Why doesn't anything work in the main interface especially with external storage connected?**

**A1:** Correct Input Source must be selected when you use the USB disk, otherwise no signal will be shown on the screen.

**[Wifi Connection]Q: When the projector opens the same screen mirror interface, no signal blue screen is displayed, and WiFi does not display?**

**A1:** Attempt to power off and restart whether to recover.

**[Screen Mirroring]Q: Video cannot be mirrored to the projector? Or is there sound or picture in the mirror image? No picture, no sound?**

**A1:** Copyrighted cannot be mirrored on the same screen, for example (prime, Hulu, Netflix, Disney +).

**PS:** (prime, Hulu, Netflix, Disney +) streaming media with copyright can try to play the same screen on the web page.

**A2:** Is the source resolution too high (For example 4k, 8k)? Or the video refresh rate exceeds 60hz?

Please note that the projector only supports 60Hz and the video source cannot exceed 1080P.

**[Screen Mirroring]Q: Screen mirror jam, frame drop, delay, automatic disconnection?**

**A1:** The smoothness of the screen image is related to the quality of the network.

**[Screen Mirroring]Q: Screen mirroring can't connect to the network?**

**A1:** The router at home is fully connected (sometimes the connection of our mobile phones is unsuccessful, and the router itself limits the number of connected devices).

**A2:** The password entered is incorrect (check the password).

**A3:** The machine is too far from the router device.

**A4:** If the WiFi of the machine fails, turn it off and start it for test, or restore the factory setting once.

**[HD Connection]Q: Why does the projector show "No Signal" when HD connecting with phone?**

**A1:** Please read the instructions of the HD adapter carefully before connecting.

**A2:** Please make sure to use an original cable, check the correct HD ports, or any damage of the cable.

**A3:** For the first time connection to some computers, it needs to make setting of the projector: Set - display - set the projector as the second screen.
