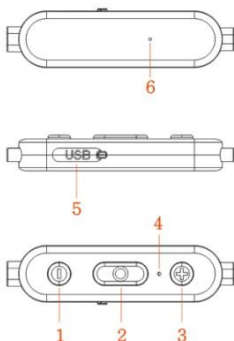

# Panel Button Description



1. Volume -/last song:  
click this button to reduce the volume, while  
press this button with holding for 1 second to  
play the last song.
2. Function key: with 3 different functions
  - Power on or off: keep pressing for 3  
seconds.
  - Answer or hang up the phone, click once.
  - Click once you can to play or pause while

listening the music

3. Volume +/-next song:

click this button to add the volume, while press this button with holding for 1 second to play the next song

4. Indicator light: there are 5 states

●Red and blue lights flicker alternately: no device has been connected after power on. At this time, you can connect to your mobile phone.

●Blue light with low frequency flashing: bluetooth device is connected.

●Red light with low frequency flashing: means the battery is low and you need to recharge your headphones.

●Keeps on a red states: charging.

●Keeps on blue states: charging completed

# Operating instruction

1. Turn on/off and connect with the mobile phone:

To start up is that hold down the function key for 3 seconds, and the red and blue lights will flicker alternately. At this time, the device is in the pairing state and can be paired with the phone. Turn on the bluetooth function of the mobile phone, search for the bluetooth name "FF216" and click the connection. After successful connection, the headset will turn to blue light and slowly flash. To shut down is that hold down the function key for 3 seconds in the startup state.

2. Answer the phone:

when there is a new call, click the function button to get through the line.

3. Hang up:

during the call, click the function button to hang up.

4. **Reject incoming calls:**  
when a call comes in, press the function button and hold it for 1 second. You can reject incoming calls.
