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Using the FM Radio

Power the speaker ON. Press the [M] button on the speaker's control panel until you hear a voice indicating FM radio mode. The LED screen will show a small "FM" icon, and will display the current radio frequency.

When using the FM radio for the first time in a new location, press and hold the [FM] button on the speaker's control panel to start scanning and saving available radio stations. The LED screen will display the stations being saved. Once the speaker has scanned all the way through and saved all available stations, it will automatically return to the lowest FM frequency and stop scanning.

In FM radio mode, adjust playback with the buttons on the control panel.

- Press and hold the [FM] button to start/stop scanning and saving available radio stations.

- Press the [FM] and [FM] buttons to flip through previously saved stations.
- Press and hold the [FM] and [FM] buttons to manually move through FM frequencies.

- Press the [FM] button to mute and unmute.

True Wireless (TWS) Pairing

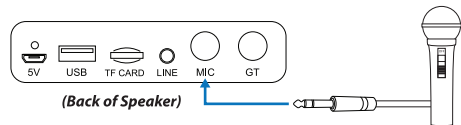
You can pair two WST1080 speakers together to make a stereo pair.

Power both speakers ON, or switch both to Bluetooth pairing mode. Press and hold one speaker's [PAIRING] button until you hear a voice indicating that they have connected.

Once the speakers have connected to each other, follow the **Bluetooth Pairing** instructions in this manual to pair your device to them.

Using the Mic & Guitar Inputs

Power the speaker ON. Plug the compatible 1/4" connector of a microphone or guitar into the microphone or guitar input ports on the back of the speaker. They can be used at the same time as you play music in your mode.



Press the [MIC PRIO] button turn Microphone Priority ON or OFF. The LED screen will show "P ON" or "P OFF". When Mic Prio is on, the music will mute while you speak or sing into the microphone.

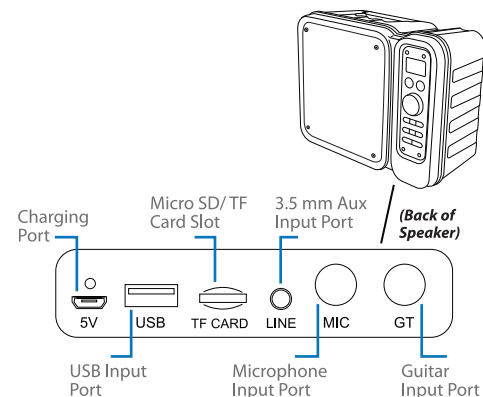

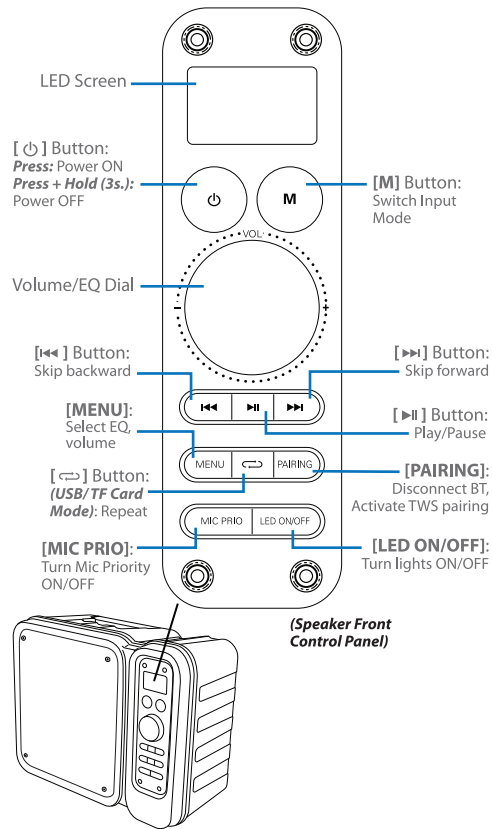

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Getting Started

Charging the Speaker

Plug the small connector of the included charging cable into the 5V micro-USB charging port on the back of the speaker. Plug the large connector into the USB port on a computer, a USB charging device, or a **5V USB adapter** (not included) and plug into an electrical outlet.

The LED indicator above the charging port will light up while charging and turn off when fully charged.

Powering ON/OFF

- Press the **[P]** button to power the speaker ON.
- Press and hold the **[P]** button for 3 seconds to power OFF.

Using the Lights

- In any mode, press the **[LED ON/OFF]** button to turn the speaker lights ON and OFF.

Playing Music

To listen to music on your speaker, you must be paired to a Bluetooth device, plugged into a device via the AUX input, or playing music directly from a USB device or TF card. Please consult the appropriate sections later in this manual for more info.

When playing audio via Bluetooth or 3.5 mm aux connection, playback and volume adjustment can be controlled with your connected device. Playback and volume can be adjusted with the controls on the speaker in Bluetooth, USB, micro SD card and FM radio mode.

Adjusting Volume & EQ

In all modes, volume and EQ can be adjusted with the controls on the speaker.

Adjust EQ by pressing **[MENU]** on the control panel and turning the volume dial to adjust:

- Press **[MENU]** *once* to adjust **mic echo**. The LED screen will show "E."
- Press **[MENU]** *2 times* to adjust **bass**. The LED screen will show "b."
- Press **[MENU]** *3 times* to adjust **treble**. The LED screen will show "t."
- Press **[MENU]** *4 times* to adjust **mic volume**. The LED screen will show "n."

Changing Input Modes

Press the **[M]** button on the speaker's control panel to switch between Bluetooth, AUX, USB, Micro SD/TF Card, and FM Radio modes. You must have an AUX device, USB device or micro SD/TF card connected or inserted to switch to those modes.

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Bluetooth Pairing

1. Power the speaker ON. A voice will be heard, and the speaker will automatically power ON in Bluetooth mode.
2. Set your mobile device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **WST1080** from the list of found devices.
