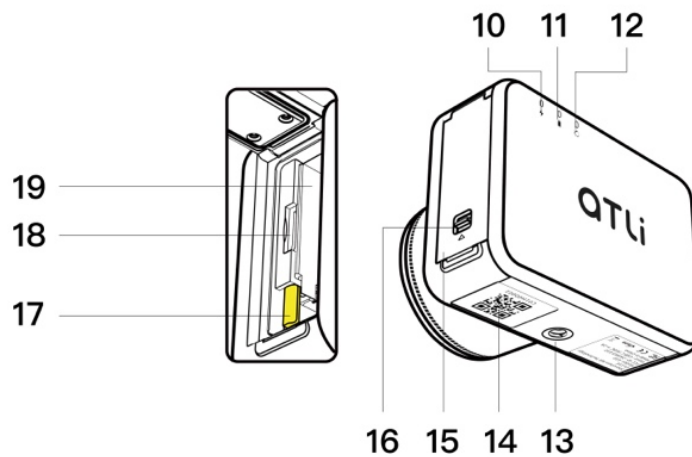

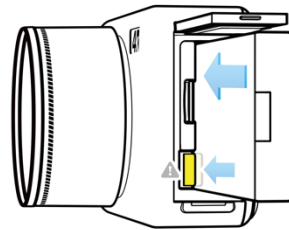
Battery

Inserting Battery

1 Pull the door latch down till the door pops open.



2 Adjust the battery until the “ATLi” logos are aligned in the same direction.

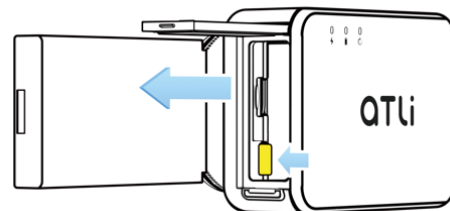


3 Use the battery to push the yellow latch back until the battery can be inserted.

4 Slide in the battery until the yellow latch click in to lock the battery in place.

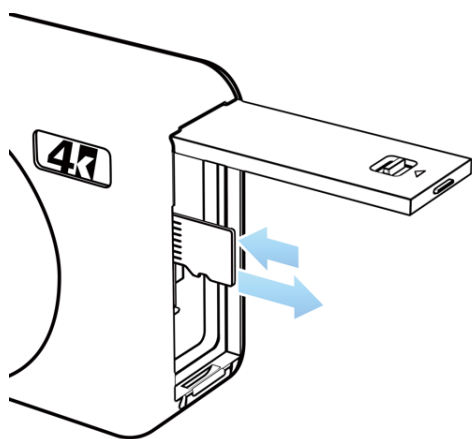
Removing the Battery

1 To remove the battery, turn the camera off, pull down the door latch to open the Battery/Card door.



2 Press the yellow latch so that the battery can be released. Pull the battery tab to slide out the battery.

Memory Card Requirement

- Type: microSD
- Capacity: Support max.512GB
- Speed Class: U3
- Format: exFat

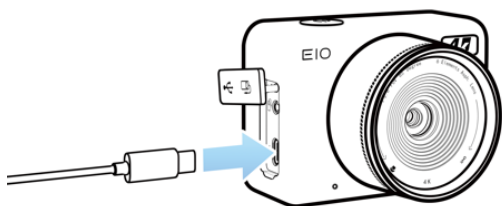
Inserting MicroSD card

- 1** Open the Battery/Card door.
- 2** Orient the card so that the metal contacts facing toward the front side of the camera and the card cut out facing down.
- 3** Slide in the memory card until it clicks.

Removing memory card

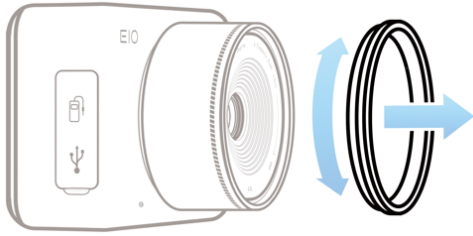
To remove the memory card, press the card in and then release slowly. The card will then eject out a little and can be removed by hand.

Charging



- 1** Pry open the silicone cover.
- 2** Connect the USB-C port to an external USB power source with a minimum rating of 5V@1A.

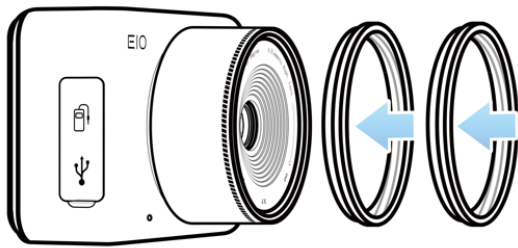
Remove UV Filter



To remove the UV filter from the lens, grip the edge of the filter and turn it counterclockwise (to the left).

Add-On Filter

This product accommodates common 52mm filters, enabling you to enhance your camera's functionality to precisely align with your artistic vision and adapt to diverse shooting conditions.






1 Screw clockwise an add-on filter on the UV Filter or on the Focus Ring (remove the UV filter first).

2 Add more filters on top as required.

Status Indicators

The camera features three indicator lights for essential feedback:
the Charging indicator displays charging status;
the Battery indicator indicates battery status,
the Operation indicator reflects camera running states.

ATLI Cam+ app

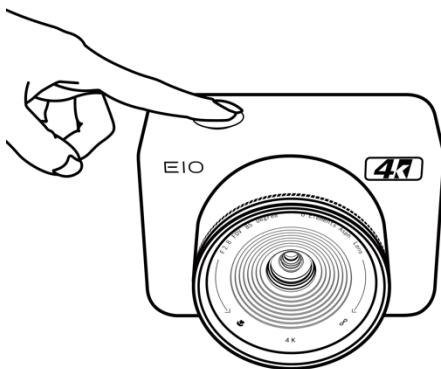
This app connects your mobile device to ATLI cameras for easy management and operation.

Camera Registration



1 Open ATLI Cam+ and go to the camera list > [Add Camera].

2 Long press the power button for 3 secs to turn on the camera. Wait approx. 10 secs until the operation indicator  turns green.

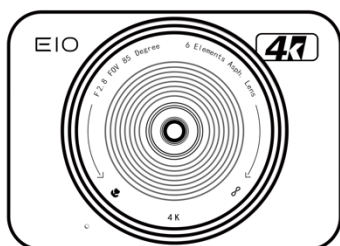
3 Scan the QR code located at the bottom of the camera and complete the registration process.

Manual Focus

This camera features a manual focus system, allowing users to adjust the focus of the camera to achieve sharp and clear images.



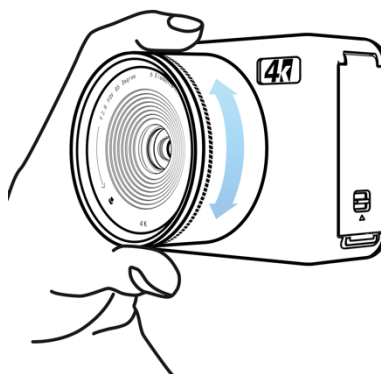
Subjects beyond 1 meter

For subjects over 1 meter, rotate the focus ring to the preset position (as shown on the left). When it reaches this position, you will feel it click into place.

Subjects within 6 cm to 1 meter

1 Adjust the camera's focus ring slowly until the image appears clear and sharp on the live feed.

2 To achieve precise focus, use the magnify feature by long-tapping on the screen. This will zoom in and allow you to check the details more closely.
