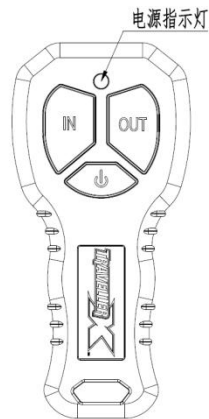


## TSC remote control usage instructions

1. The function description of the panel buttons is shown in the figure



2. Function description: Press and hold the button for 3 seconds to turn on the device, and the blue wireless indicator light will stay on. Automatically turn off power within 2 minutes without any operation. Press the OUT button and the blue indicator light will flash to release the winch rope. Press the IN button and the blue indicator light will flash. The winch will retract the rope.
3. Remote control distance: 26 meters, frequency: 315MHz
4. The transmitter should automatically shut down after 2 minutes of no operation after being turned on
5. Transmission voltage: DC3.6V Receiver voltage: DC9-15V

#### FCC Statement:
