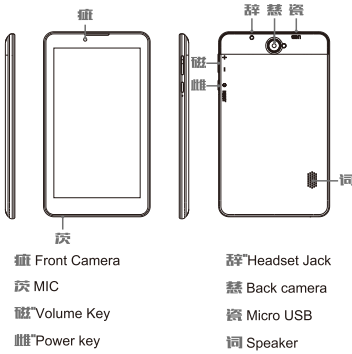

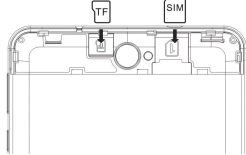

Power off your phone before installing or removing SIM card.



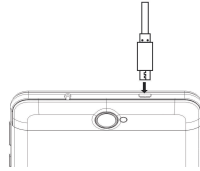

Charging V97L



Use the charger that comes in-box with your tablet to charge the battery.

Specific Absorption Rate (SAR)

Your mobile device is a radio transmitter and receiver. It is designed not to exceed the limits for exposure to radio waves recommended by international guidelines. These guidelines were developed by the independent scientific organization ICNIRP and include safety margins designed to assure the protection of all persons, regardless of age and health. The guidelines use a unit of measurement known as Specific Absorption Rate, or SAR.

The SAR limit for mobile devices is 2 W/kg.

The highest SAR value for this device when tested at the head was 0.773 W/kg*, and when tested at the body was 1.368 W/kg* with 5 mm distance.


As mobile devices offer a range of functions, they can be used in other positions, such as on the body.

As SAR is measured utilizing the device's highest transmitting power, the actual SAR of this device while operating is typically below that indicated above. This is due to automatic changes to the power level of the device to ensure it only uses the minimum power required to communicate with the network.
