HDMI Mode: If your TV with HD port ,then HD mode is suggested.

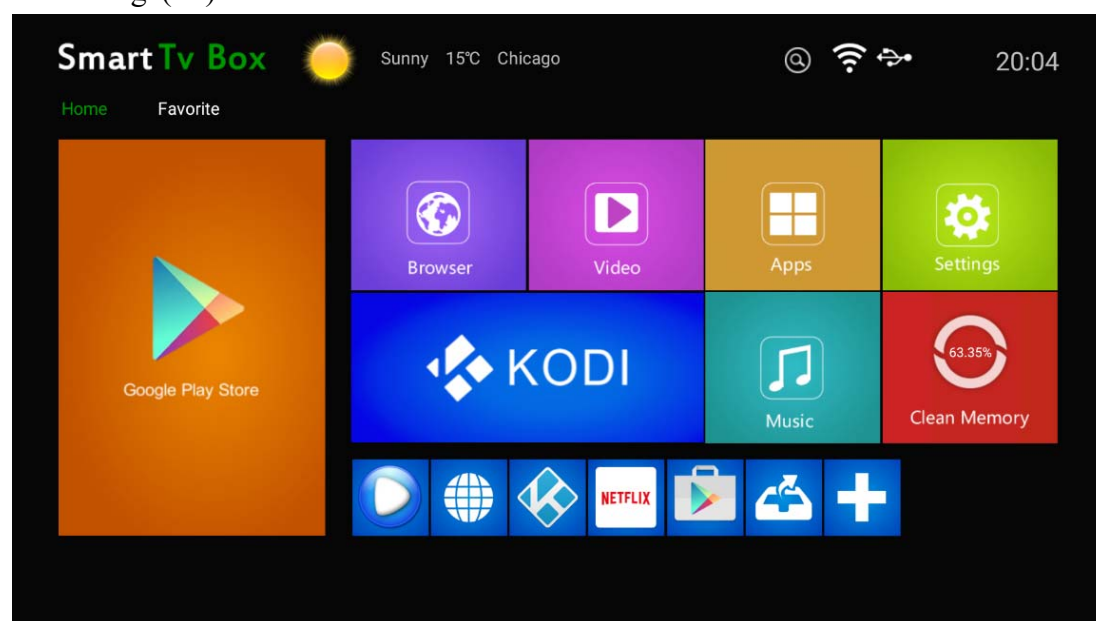
3.2 Start up

Turn on the player while indicator light is blue, about 25 seconds to enter into Home Page(UI).

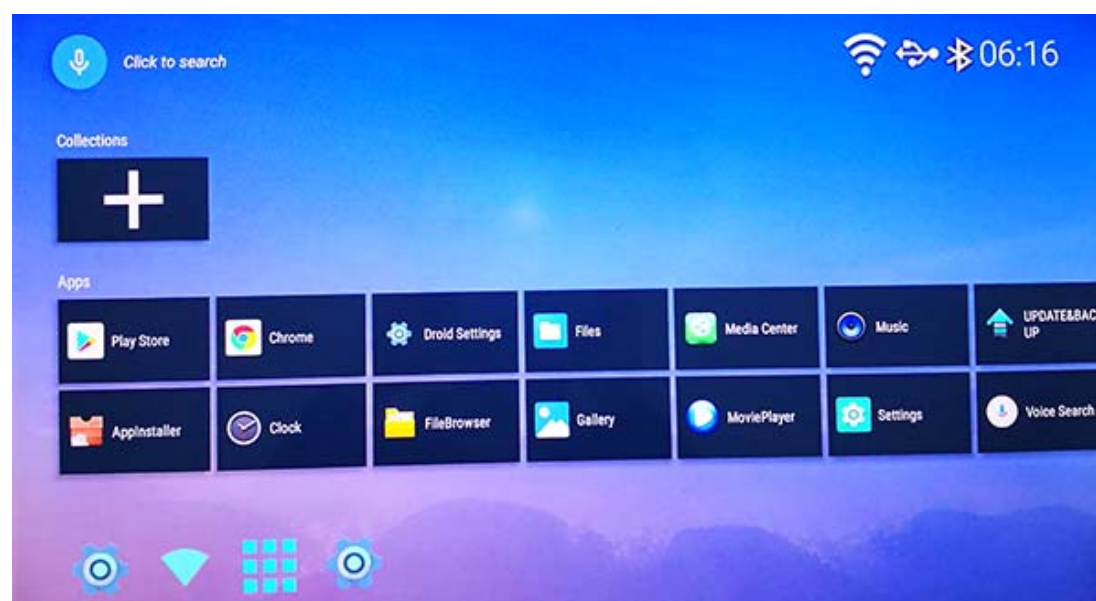

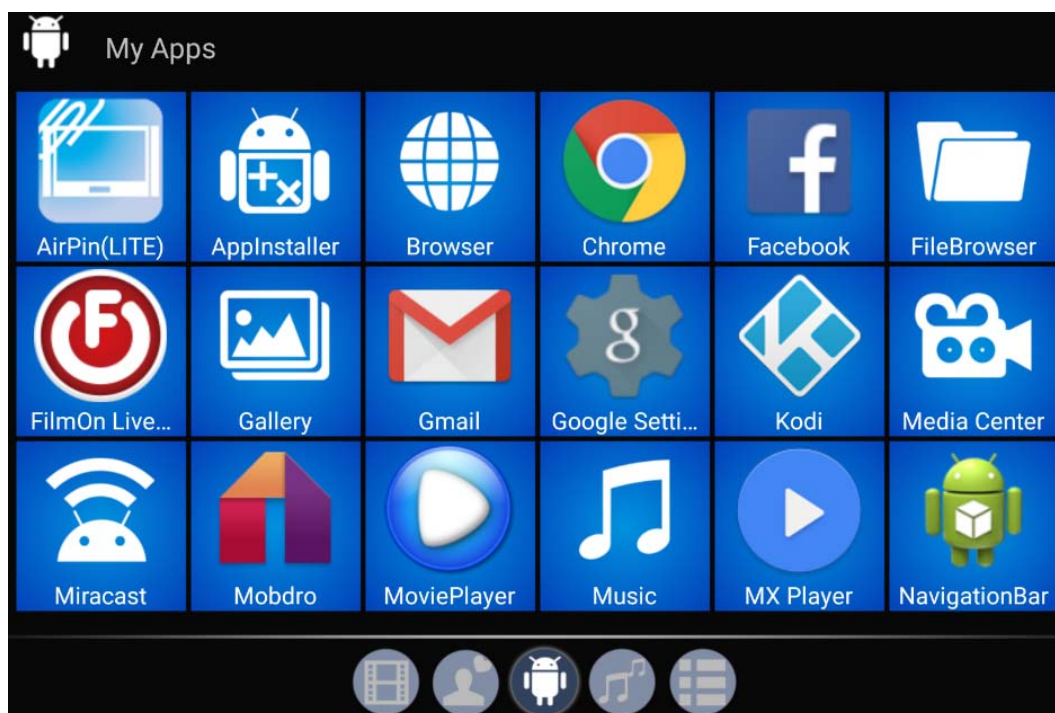
You can add the apps according to your own preference from “+”.

Here you can cut, copy, paste and move the files and folder between the local disk and external storage card.

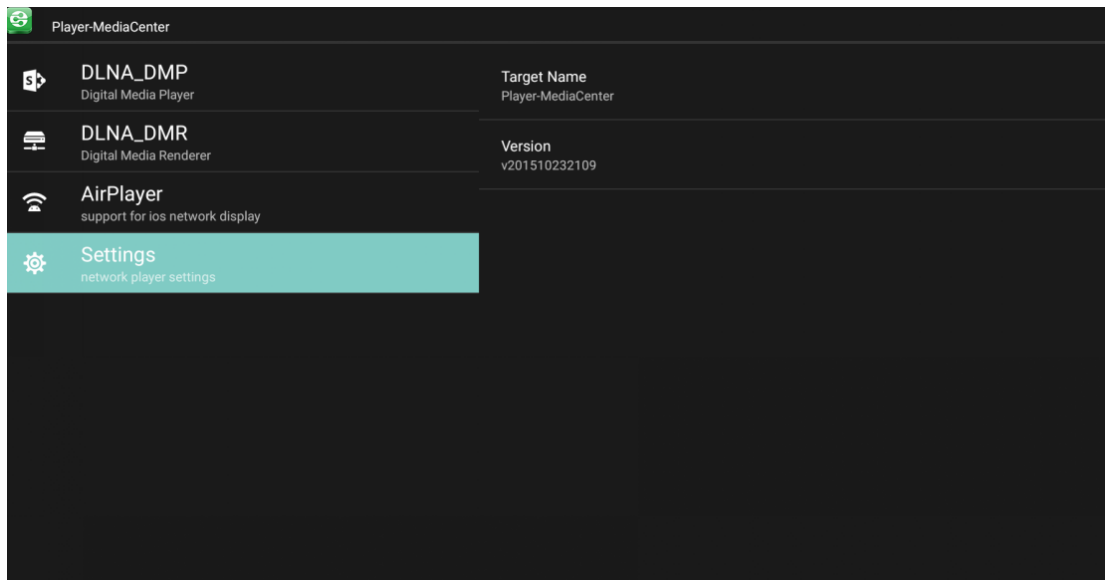
5.8 Music

5.10 OTA Update

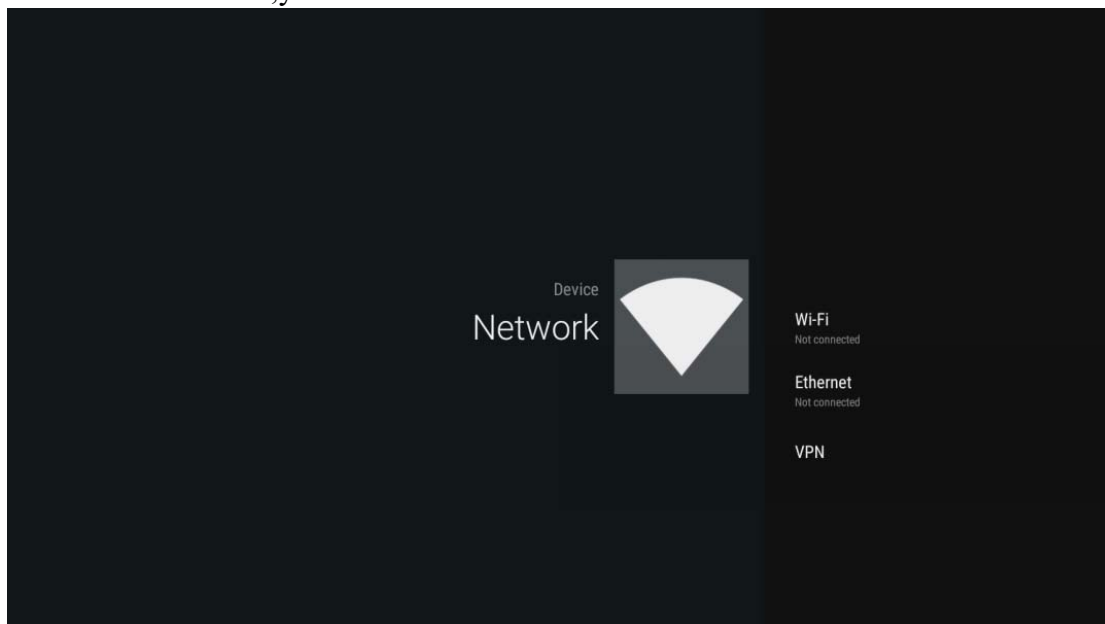
This function can not be use.

Chapter 7 Trouble shooting

Warning

Under no circumstances should you try to repair the TV box by yourself, as this will invalidate warranty. Do not open the TV box as there is a risk of electric shock. If a fault occurs, first check with points listed below before taking the TV box for repair. If you are unable to remedy a problem by following hints, consult your dealer for help.

Problem	Solutions
No Power	<ul style="list-style-type: none">·Check if the power adaptor is properly connected to the power and the TV box.·Press the power on the remote controller to turn on the power.

No picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Re-connect with HD cable or AV cable
No sound or distorted sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Adjust the volume. · Check that the speakers are connected correctly.
No audio or digital output	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Check the digital connections. · Check if your amplifier is set correctly
The player does not respond to the Remote Control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Aim the remote control directly at the sensor on the front of the TV box. · Reduce the distance to the TV box. · Replace the batteries in the remote control.
Player does not respond to some operating commands during	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Operations may not be permitted. Refer to the user manual. · Possibility of system halted, re-insert with power adaptor to restart.
No sound during movies playback	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · The audio codec may not be supported by the TV box. You can change to the supported audio on playing menu. · Check the volume.
The contents of the USB flash drive cannot be read	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · The USB flash drive format is not compatible with the box. · If one of the USB cannot be read, please turn off the TV box for 30 seconds and restart the TV box.
Slow operation of the USB flash drive	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Big file size or high resolution USB flash drive takes longer time to read and display on the TV screen.
No sound with HDMI connection	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Check the connection between the TV and the HDMI jack of box. · Check your TV system setup. · Check the volume
