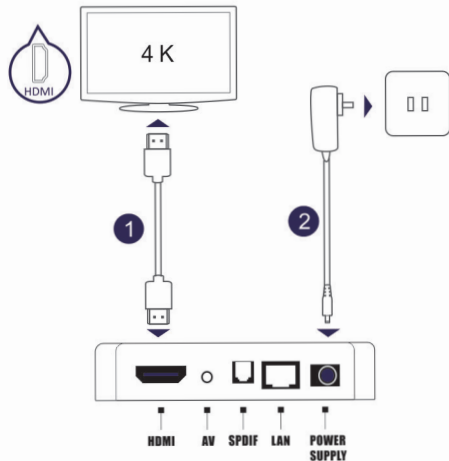




# Basic Installation

Connect to LAN or  
Wifi after power on



## 1 HDMI Connection

Connect HDMI cable from box to HD TV.

## 2 Power Connection

Once plug in the power cord, it will power on automatically then wait for the LED display.

## 3 Switching to the correct output source

Use the TV remote control to power on TV, then switch to the correct HDMI input source. Once correct, the TV should display the box home interface.

## 4 Complete setting

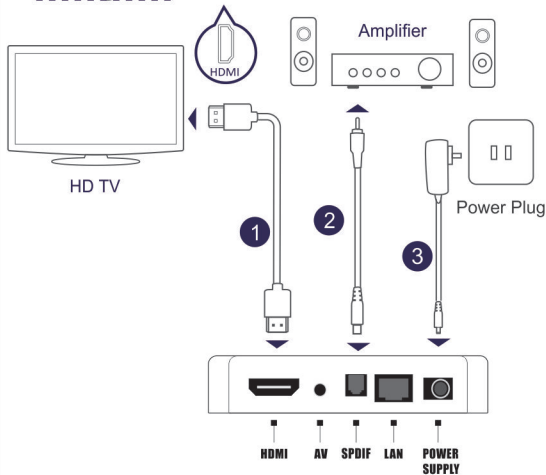
Follow the startup instruction to finish the basic setting.

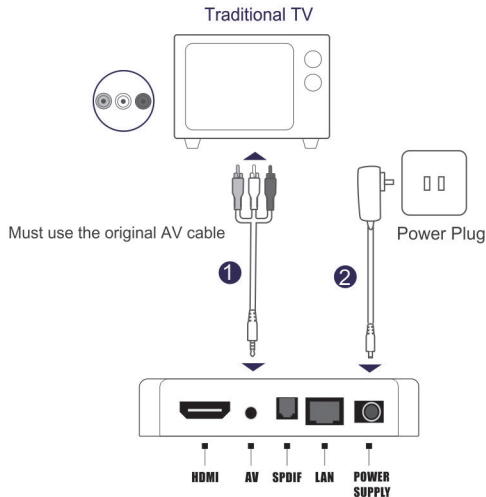
