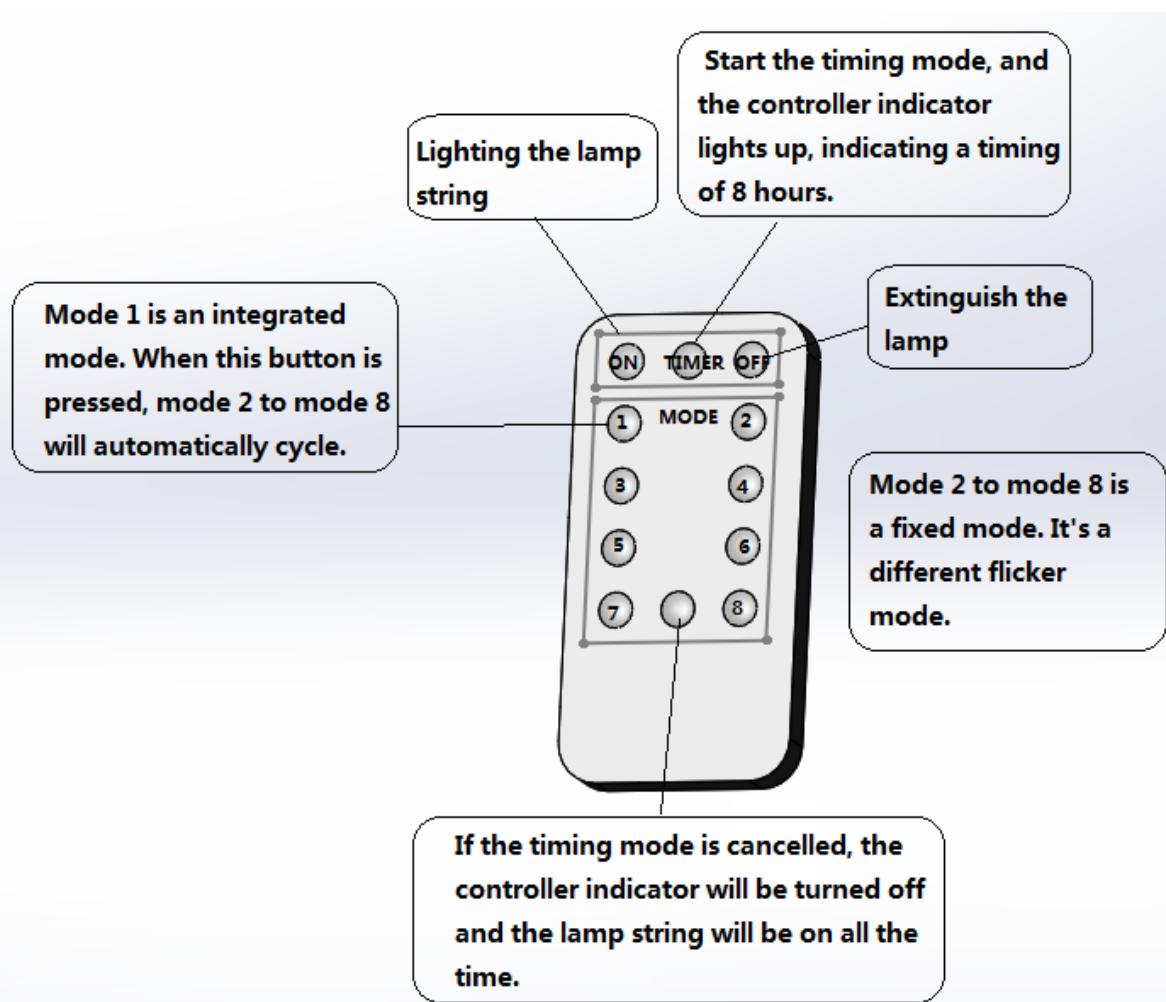

Remote Controller Programming

Put the lights with controllers in series on the power supply, and press 7 and 8 on the remote control panel at the same time. At this time, the lights will flash to indicate the success of the matching.

If the pairing is successful, the controller will have a memory state. Next time the controller is re-energized, it will operate directly without re-pairing.
