



SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS:

Read this manual carefully before using the speaker and keep this manual for future reference.

- Keep the ban.dō shower speaker away from heat, direct flame, direct sunlight, and sharp edges.
- To avoid risk of short circuit do not insert any unintended metal object into the ban.dō shower speaker.
- To avoid a static charge, do not use the ban.dō shower speaker in an extremely dry climate.
- Do not submerge in water.
- Slightly moisten suction cup with water and firmly press to flat, clean, dry surface making sure there are no air bubbles.
- Not a toy. Keep out of children's reach.



Accessories included: 1 USB charging cable

TO CHARGE INTEGRATED LITHIUM BATTERY:

1. Insert the charging cable into the DC 5V socket on the speaker. Connect the USB plug into a computer or AC/DC adaptor with DC 5V 500mA.
2. The LED indicator turns red when the battery is being charged.
3. The red LED indicator turns off when the battery is fully charged.
4. When not charging, place cover securely over DC 5V socket to ensure water resistance.
5. Do not charge in the shower or other wet environments.

PAIRING BAN.DO SHOWER SPEAKER BLUETOOTH® TO A MOBILE PHONE/DEVICE:

Ban.dō shower speaker

1. Important! Start with your ban.dō shower speaker in the off mode.
2. Press and hold the on/off button for about 3 seconds until the blue LED is flashing alternately.
3. The ban.dō shower speaker is now ready for pairing.

MOBILE PHONE OR DEVICE:

1. Turn on your mobile phone/ device and activate the Bluetooth® function.
2. Search for Bluetooth® devices until you see "ban.dō".
3. Pair your device with "ban.dō". If a password is needed, type in "0000".
4. After "ban.dō" is paired, connect it to your device.
5. Once the speaker is paired and connected to your mobile phone/device, the next time the speaker is on, it will connect to your mobile phone/device automatically as long as the Bluetooth® in your mobile phone is on.

BUTTON DESCRIPTION:



On/Off



Short press for the previous song, long press to turn down the volume



Short press for next song, long press to turn up the volume



Play/pause music



Answer incoming call

• You can press the phone button twice quickly to redial the last phone call.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

SYMPTOMS	CAUSES	SOLUTIONS
Speaker will not turn on	Battery not charged	Charge battery
Unable to pair the speaker	Speaker is switched on, but it is not in pairing mode	Refer to the section "Pairing the ban.dō shower speaker to Mobile Phone/Device"
