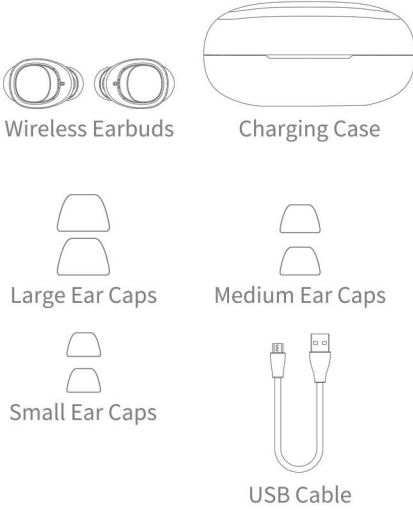

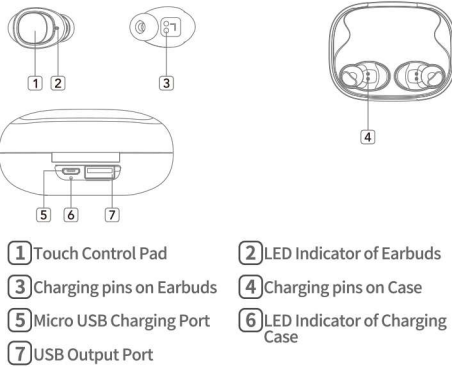

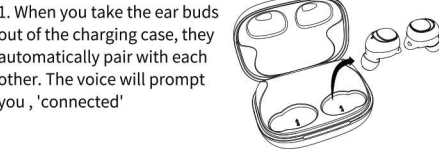


How to Wear



Quick Guide

First use:



2. Enable Bluetooth on your phone or device and search for “F16-R” or “F16-L” to connect either one. The voice will prompt you “Pairing Successful” , then “Connected” will follow when pairing is successful.

After connecting either L/R, Android or Apple device will prompt a pairing request. Select ‘Pair’ , the pairing procedure will be complete.

Second Use

When you remove the Earbuds from the Charging Case, they will automatically connect to your phone or device. If the Earbuds do not connect automatically, you will need to click the previous connection record and click connect.

Note: If Bluetooth cannot find the Earbuds or the pairing is not successful, please put the Earbuds back in the Charging Case and reset the Earbuds. If you encounter any problems during the use of the Earbuds, resetting the Earbuds will solve it.

Resetting Step

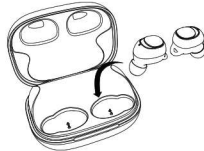
1. Turn on the Bluetooth of your device and remove previous Earbuds pairing history. Then turn Bluetooth “Off” .
2. Put the Earbuds into the charging case. Quick tap the touch control pad on each Earbud 3 times until the white indicator light flashes once.
3. Turn on Bluetooth again and re-pair like the first use.

Power On

The Earbuds will automatically turn on once they have been taken out of the charging case and a voice will say “Power on”. The LED will flash white on Earbuds.

Power Off

1. Put the two Earbuds into the Charging Case and they will turn off automatically.



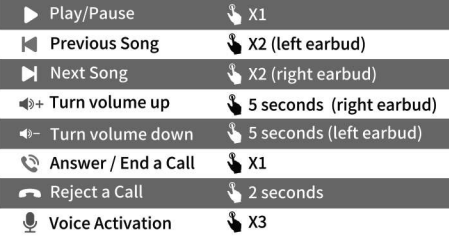
2. Turn off the Bluetooth on your phone and the Earbuds will turn off within 5 minutes.

Mono Mode

Either Right or Left Earbuds can perform as a mono wireless Earbuds. Pick up either Right or Left Earbud from the Charging Case, it will automatically power on and enter into pairing mode. Turn on your Bluetooth device, search and select “F16-L” or “F16-R” to connect.

Note: To enter Mono mode, one of the Earbuds need to remain in the Charging Case

Control



Play/Pause: Tap the Touch control pad once

Previous Song: Double-Tap the touch pad on left Earbud

Next Song: Double-Tap the touch pad on right Earbud

Turn volume up: Long-press the right earbud for 5 seconds

Turn volume down: Long-press the left earbud for 5 seconds

Answer / End a Call: Tap the Touch control pad once

Reject a Call: Press the touch pad for 2 seconds

Voice Activation: Quick tap the touch pad 3 times

How to Charge

1. Earbuds

When the Earbuds battery is low, the LED will illuminate in red and a voice will say “Battery Low”

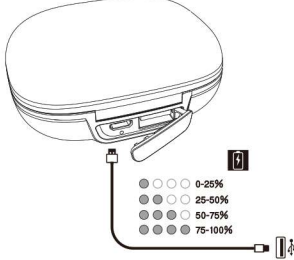
Return the Earbuds back to the charging case, the case will charge the Earbuds automatically. The LED of the Earbuds will be illuminate in red while charging. The LED of the Earbuds will turn off once fully charged.

2. Charging Case

The charging case can be charged via Micro USB and its LED indicator will indicate the battery level status.

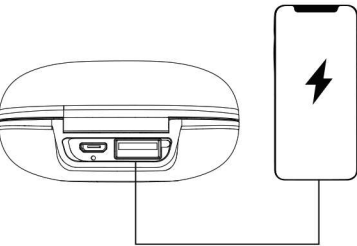
LED indicator of Charging Case while being Charging	Battery Percentage
Flash Once in 2 Seconds	0-25%
Flash Twice in 2 Seconds	25-50%
Flash Three Times in 2 Seconds	50-75%
Flash Four Times in 2 Seconds	75-100%

3. Charge other devices

The charging case has a built-in 2200mAh capacity battery that can charge your phone 1-2 times.



Troubleshooting

Problems	Possible Causes	Solutions
Can't turn on	Earbuds may have low battery level	Return them back to the case and charge
Earbuds don't charge or LED Indicator light does not turn on	The battery level of the charging case is too low, Or, the charging pins between Earbuds and Charging Case is not connected properly.	Charge the Charging Case for 2 hours and then return the Earbuds back to the Charging Case to charge them. Ensure the charging pins are connected.
Pairing failure	/	Follow directions to reset your earbuds
Left and Right earbuds do not synchronize	/	Follow directions to reset your earbuds
