Fill in required data –choice area of the phone. No number, made password to start the log in ,

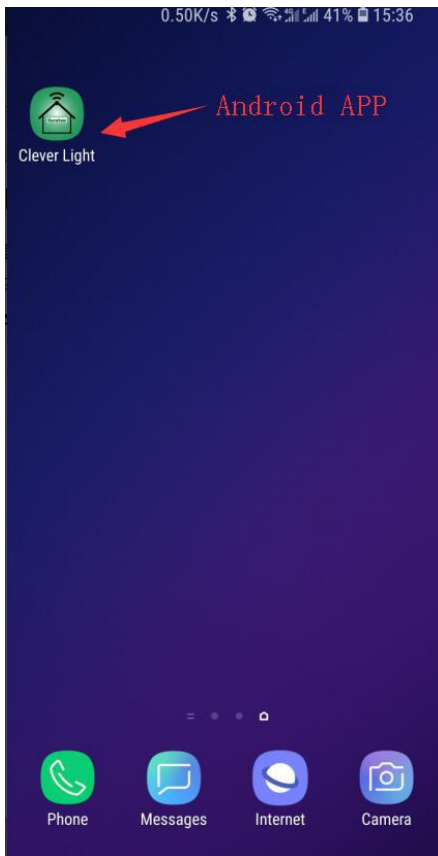

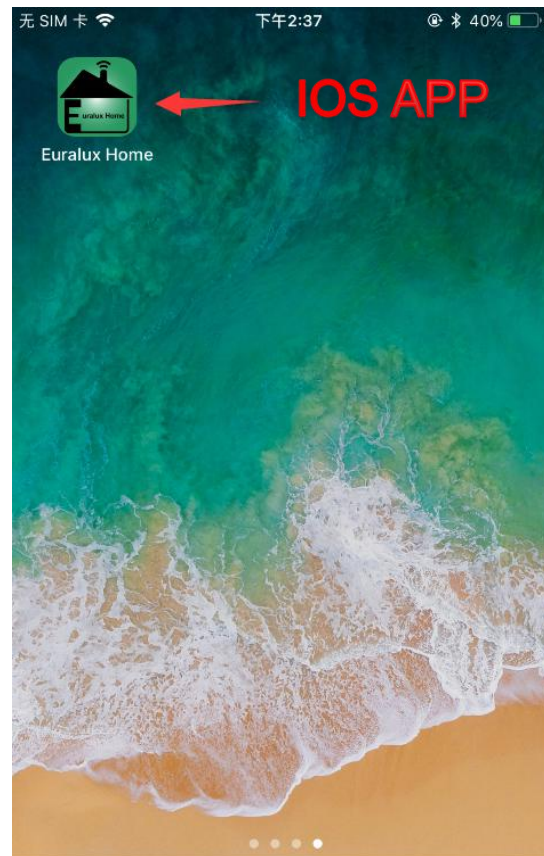

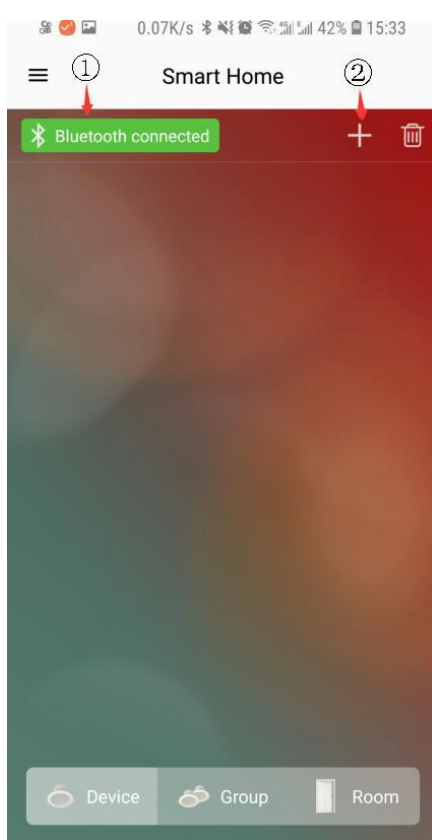

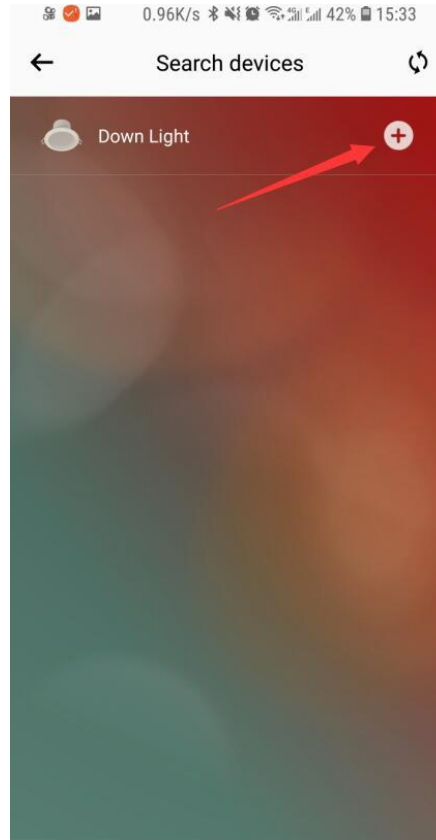

2. Dimming light range 5% -100%)

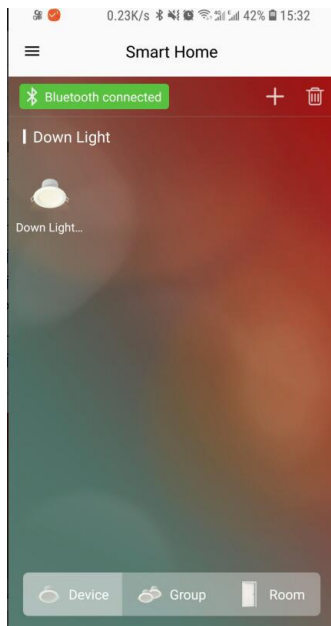
