 - Do not submerge or drop the Speaker in water.

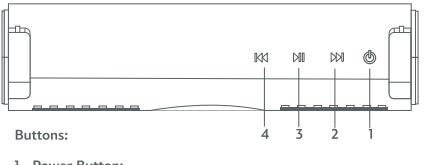
Product Features

- **Bluetooth Audio:** Bluetooth 5.4, range of 10–15 meters.
- **Bluetooth Call:** Clear voice quality with no echo.
- **MP3 Playback:** Plays MP3 files from TF card.
- **Audio Input:** Connects to computers, music players, phones, etc.
- **Breakpoint Memory:** Remembers last track and volume on exit.
- **Built-in Battery:** Rechargeable lithium battery; energy-saving and eco-friendly.

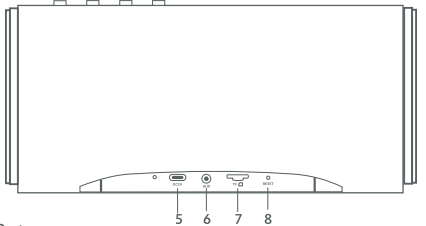
Music Playback Operation

- Upon power-on, the device defaults to Bluetooth mode.
- Inserting a TF card switches to TF mode automatically.
- Inserting an AUX cable switches to AUX mode automatically.
- You can switch modes manually using the Power/Mode button.
- For more details, refer to the Button and Port Functions section.

Button and Port Functions



- Buttons:**
- 1 - Power Button:**
- Long Press: Power ON/OFF.
 - Short Press: Switch playback modes.
 - In Call Mode: Answer/End call.
- 2 - Next Song Button:**
- Short Press: Next track.
 - Long Press: Volume up.
- 3 - Play/Pause Button:**
- Short Press: Play/Pause.
 - Long Press: Disconnect/Reconnect Bluetooth.
 - Double press: TWS pairing
- 4 - Previous Song Button:**
- Short Press: Previous track.
 - Long Press: Volume down.



- Ports:**
- 5 - TYPE-C Interface:**
- Charging port (DC 5V).
- 7 - TF Card Slot:**
- Insert TF card for MP3 playback.
- 6 - AUX Interface:**
- 3.5 mm external audio input.
- 8 - RESET Hole:**
- Press with a pin for 8 seconds to reset device.

Indicator Light

- **Charging:** Red light ON while charging; turns OFF when fully charged.

Bluetooth Connection Instructions

- Long press Play/Pause button to enter Bluetooth mode. You'll hear a prompt, and the Bluetooth icon will flash.
- Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device and search for "Disney Adventure Speaker".
- Select "Disney Adventure Speaker" from the list. A prompt will confirm a successful connection.

(If prompted for a password, enter 0000.)

- Previously paired devices will connect automatically when Bluetooth is enabled within 10 seconds of power-on.

Charging Instructions

- Connect the included charging cable to the TYPE-C port.
- Connect the other end to a USB port or 5V/1.5A charger.
- Charging time: Approx. 3–4 Hours
- Red light indicates charging; turns off when fully charged.

Note: The device includes overcharge protection and can stay connected to the charger without issue.

Low Battery Notice

- A voice prompt will alert you when the battery is low.
- The speaker will shut down automatically if not charged.
- If unused for long periods, charge the device at least once a month to prolong battery life.

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: Does it shut down automatically after turning on?**
- A: Yes, if the battery is low. Charge speaker for at least 2 hours before use.
- Q: Blue light flashes then device shuts down?**
- A: Yes, that indicates battery is low.
- Q: Device won't charge?**
- A: Use the original charging cable. Ensure the USB port or charger is functioning properly.
- Q: Red charging light is off or dim?**
- A: This is normal. The light dims or turns off when the battery is nearly or fully charged.

- Q: No sound?**
- A: Make sure the correct mode is selected, and volume is adjusted appropriately.
- Q: No sound in AUX mode?**
- A: Use the provided audio cable. Switch to AUX mode manually using the power button. Check the volume on the external device.

- Q: Bluetooth does not auto-connect?**
- A: Only paired devices auto-connect. If more than 10 seconds have passed after entering Bluetooth mode, connection must be manual.

- Q: No sound from Bluetooth?**
- A: Ensure Bluetooth is connected. Check volume on the connected device.
- Q: Buttons not working?**
- A: Restart the device by turning it off and on again or use reset hole to reset the device.
