FOR PARENTS ONLY HOW TO USE YOUR SPECIAL STAR TO LEAD SANTA'S SCOUT TO YOUR YARD...

1. On Christmas Eve, hang your Special Star outside where Santa's Scout will arrive in your yard.
2. With children, read the story of Santa's Scout to learn what he is all about.
3. Prompt children to place their own Scout in a window with glowing nose facing out.

Parents: To operate the light up star, point the wireless remote control in the direction of the star (up to 15 meters) and select the desired mode (flashing, steady, off) on the remote control.

Requires 6 x 1.5 V LR44/SR44 button cell batteries (star) and 1 x 1.5 V button cell battery (remote). See important battery use and disposal information below. Contains button coin cell battery.

Hazardous if swallowed- see information below. KEEP BATTERIES OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Parental supervision is required when replacing batteries. Dispose of batteries safely and based on waste regulations.



As with all small batteries, the batteries used with this product should be kept away from small children who still put things in their mouths. This product contains a Button or Coin Cell Battery. A swallowed Button or Coin Cell Battery can cause internal chemical burns in as little as two hours and lead to death. Dispose of used batteries immediately. TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE
