Operation Guide

- Power Headphones ON/OFF:** Long press the POWER Button for 3 seconds.
- PLAY / PAUSE:** Short Press the POWER Button.
- Switch Modes:** To switch between playback modes, short press the M Button.
- Previous / Next Tracks:** To play the previous track, short press the Previous Track / Volume Down Button. To play the next track, short press the Next Track / Volume Up Button.
- Volume Up / Down:** To toggle volume, short press the Volume Up Button / Volume Down Button.
- Calling:** Short press the Call Button to answer or end a call. Long press the Call Button to reject a call. Double-click the Call Button to redial.
- Radio Search:** To search radio stations, long press the Call Button.
- Insert Card:** The headphones will prioritize card playback upon insertion and play the contents of the card automatically.

Getting Started

LED Indicator

- When the headphones are ON, the LED indicator will flash **RED** and **BLUE**. When OFF, the LED indicator will stay **RED**.
- When Bluetooth is connected, the LED indicator will stay **BLUE**.
- When toggling between tracks or adjusting volume, the LED indicator will slowly flash **BLUE**.
- When performing actions during calls, the LED indicator will slowly flash **BLUE**.
- When the headphones automatically reconnect to the last paired device upon powering ON, the LED indicator will slowly flash **BLUE**.
- When charging, the LED indicator will stay **RED**.
- When charging is complete, the LED indicator will stay **BLUE**.
- When Bluetooth is disconnected and the headphones return to pairing mode, the LED indicator will flash **RED** and **BLUE**.
- When headphones have low battery, the LED indicator will slowly flash **RED**.
- When the headphones are in Standby Mode (connected to a device but not playing) the LED indicator will slowly flash **BLUE**.
- During radio functionality, the LED indicator will stay **BLUE**.
- During Radio Search, the LED indicator will quickly flash **BLUE**.
- When a card is inserted, the LED indicator will slowly flash **BLUE**.
- When an audio cable is inserted and the headphones are powered ON, the LED indicator will stay **RED**.

Bluetooth Pairing

- Power the speaker ON. The LED indicator will flash red and blue.
- Set your device to search for Bluetooth devices. When it appears, select **"HKBBLBTHP"** from the list of found devices.
- After a successful pairing, the LED indicator will be **BLUE** and stay on.
- The headphones will automatically power OFF in 3 minutes if they are not successfully connected.

Note:

- The headphones will automatically power OFF in 3 minutes if not connected.
- Bluetooth will automatically turn OFF when an audio cable is inserted and the headphones are powered ON.

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
