

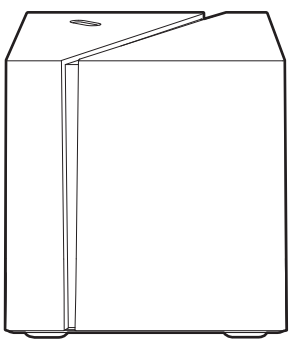

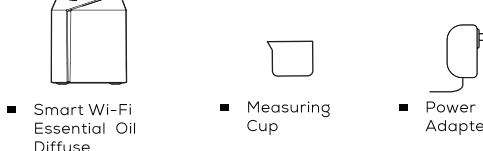

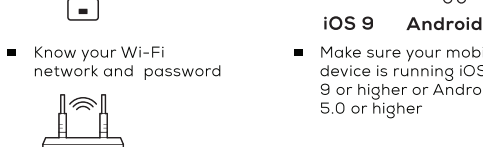

What's in the Box



Get Ready



Things you can say:

"Alexa, discover my device!"
"Alexa, turn on the bedroom light!"
"Alexa, set the bedroom light to orange!"
"Alexa, turn off the bedroom light!"
"Alexa, set the living room to 50%!"
"Alexa, turn on the diffuser!"

Q1 Open the Alexa app and go to **Skills & Games** in the menu.

Q2 Search for "Smart Wi-Fi Diffuser" in the menu.

Q3 Choose "Smart Wi-Fi Diffuser" from the list of Home Control partners.

Q4 Authorize your account with Google Assistant using the username and password from your app.

Q5 At any time, go into the "Home Control" section of the Google Home app to authorize and verify your device. **Remember: your device is not a Google Home device. It is a smart Wi-Fi diffuser.**

Product Diagram

1. Mist Nozzle
2. Outer Cover
3. Water Tank Cover
4. Base

STEP 1

1. Download the App from App Store or Google Play.

2. Register an account on your app.

3. Enter your mobile phone number or email address.

STEP 2: Getting Ready

1. Remove the outer cover.

2. Add purified water.

3. Turn the "V" button.
