❶ Connection method

Remove the earphones from the headphone compartment, close to the phone that has been turned on.

Wait about 8 seconds to turn on wireless.

Search for Wireless name and click Connect.

Automatic reconnection: If the phone has not deleted the connected headset pairing name, the headset can be automatically connected when removed from the headset box.

❸ Left ear touch control



Pause/Play (click 1 time)

Switch to the next song
(click 2 time)

Turn up the volume (click 3 time)

Reject the call
(Hold down for 2 seconds)

Voice assistant
(Hold down for 3 seconds)

❹ Right ear touch control



Pause/Play (click 1 time)

Switch to previous song
(click 2 time)

Lower the volume (click 3 time)

Reject the call
(Hold down for 2 seconds)

Voice assistant
(Hold down for 3 seconds)

❺ Precautions for use

In daily use, the charging surface of the earphone will be stained with dirt and other dirty things, you can use a cotton swab to clean the charging contact surface of the earphone.

Earphones should be used according to the requirements of the current standard, pay attention to the impact of the use of the environment on the earphones, in order to ensure a smooth connection, it is recommended that the distance between the mobile phone and the earphones within 8 meters.

If the headset is not connected or the communication is not good and other problems, please remove the headset body and accessories, otherwise there is no warranty. Do not use more than the rated ampere volt charging head to charge the headset.

In order to ensure that you can use the headphones properly, make sure that the headphones are fully charged.
