Press and hold both play and comms button for 2 seconds to enter Bluetooth® pairing mode



Connect Aleck GO! in your device's Bluetooth® settings - once connected you will hear "connected"






STEP 5 OF 5

PLAY BUTTON FUNCTIONS

- Double tap to skip track forwards
- Triple tap to skip track backwards
- Tap once to play / pause
- Tap once to answer / end call
- Press and hold for 1 second for Siri / Google Assistant
- Press and hold for 4 seconds to power on
- Press and hold for 8 seconds to power off

COMMS BUTTON FUNCTIONS

- Tap once to engage communications
- Tap again to end communications
- Press and hold to cycle through volume settings
