

In-Ear Bluetooth Headphones

Product Description

- 1. Ear Piece
- 2. Volume Up / Skip to Next Song
- Power Button (ON/OFF) / Pause/Play Answer / Hang-up Call
- 4. Volume Down / Previous Song



Ensuring a Good Fit

To enjoy better sound quality and comfortable fit, change the size of the earbuds that best fit in your ears. **DO NOT** force the earbuds in. When changing earbuds with the additional silicone earbuds, rotate while pressing down to install firmly on your headset and prevent the earbud from detaching and remaining in your ear.

How to place the headset on your ears

- 1. Hang the neck band over the back of your neck.
- 2. Gently insert the earbuds into your ear ensuring a comfortable fit.
- 3. Do the same for the other ear.

NOTE: There is a small "L" and "R" on the earbuds indicating which side ear the buds should go into.

Using your Bluetooth Headphones

Pairing Your Earbuds For the First Time

NOTE: Make sure you fully charge your Bluetooth® Earbuds prior to pairing.

- 1. On your mobile device or computer, make sure your Bluetooth® is on.
- 2. Place the Bluetooth® Earbuds in your ears.
- 3. To turn ON, press the center Power Button on the controller unit for 3-5 seconds. A blue & red light will appear and a voice prompt says "Powering On." Then you can now release the power button.
- 4. On your Bluetooth® device, select "Air Earbuds"
- Once your Bluetooth Earbuds have been successfully paired, you will hear a voice prompt that says "Connected"
- Your Bluetooth® headphones are now paired to your device.

NOTE: You can connect your Bluetooth® Earbuds to more than one device however not at the same time. For example, you can pair them to your mobile phone as well as your computer however if you have them connected to your phone, you cannot connect them to your computer at the same time.

Charging the Built-In Battery

- Charge your Bluetooth® Earbuds by using the included USB charging cable.
 Note: The LED light is lit red while the battery is charging.
- The LED light is lit blue when the battery is fully charged.
- \bullet It takes around 1.5 2 hours to fully charge the battery.
- 1. Connect the USB charging cable to the unit.
- 2. Connect the USB charging cable to your PC or USB wall charger.
- * When the battery is low, you will hear a voice prompt that says "Battery is Low,Please charge", and the LED light will blink red. After a short while, product will turn off and you will hear a voice prompt that says "Powering Off"

Basic Operation

To turn **ON**, simply hold down the power button for 3 – 5 seconds and you will hear a voice prompt that says "**Powering On**". If the device is already paired and your Bluetooth" on your device is **ON**, the LED light will quickly flash blue/red and you will hear a voice prompt that says "**Connected**".

- To Turn OFF, simply hold down the power button for 3-5 seconds. You will hear a voice prompt that says "Powering Off". The LED light will turn red for 1 second.
- To Answer a call, quickly press the center power button to accept the call.
- To End the call, quickly press the power button once.
- You can make a call by quickly pressing the power button twice it will redial your last call.
- To Pause / Play music, simply tap the center power button once (quickly).
 Note This function will only operate if your music playing application is open. Otherwise, it will dial the last number you dialed.
- To increase volume: Hold down the volume up button; to decrease volume, Hold down the volume down button. When you have reached the maximum volume, you will hear a brief tone which indicates you have reached the maximum volume level.
- To skip a song, quickly press the volume up button for 2 seconds and you'll go to the next song.
- To replay a song, quickly press the volume down button for 2 seconds and it will replay the previous song.

Battery Information

- DO NOT leave a fully charged battery connected to a charger; overcharging may shorten the battery life.
- If left unused a fully charged battery will lose its charge over time.
- · NEVER use any charger that is damaged
- NEVER leave your Bluetooth® Earbuds in excess heat. Store in a cool, dry location.
