Resetting

To connect the device to a new WiFi, use the pin to press the reset button (Figure 2). The LED will blink quickly during reset, and slow blinking indicates the device is ready to connect to a new WiFi.

Height Sensor

- Keep area under the sensor clear from objects.

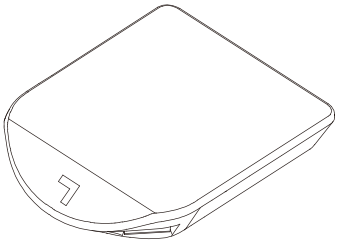
Occupational Sensor

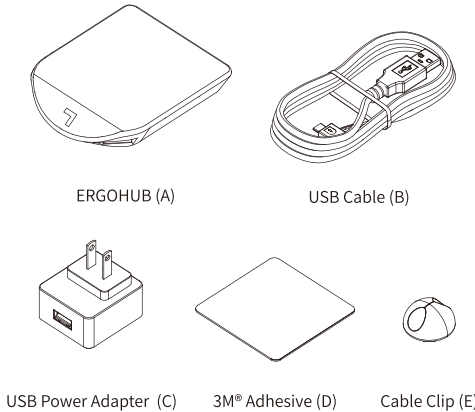

Items Included



Step 1

Attach the 3M® adhesive firmly onto the plain surface of the hub.

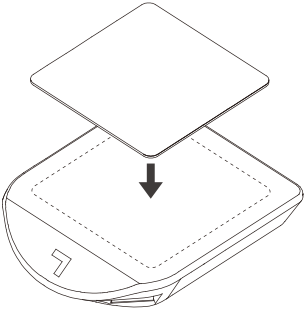

Step 2

Connect the micro USB (B) to the ERGOHUB (A) and charger (C) to the power socket. When connected successfully (Figure 2) the LED lights will blink.

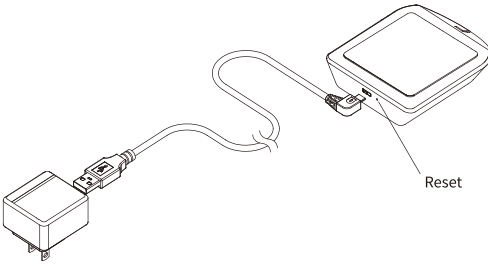

Step 3

First locate the installation point. ERGOHUB should be attached 19.5" / 50 cm to the left of the center of the desk/user (Figure 3) and aligned with the front border of the desk.

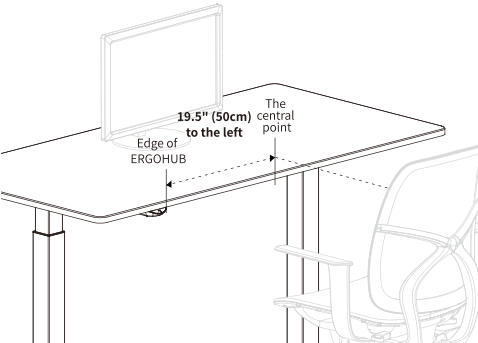

Step 4

Remove the top layer of the adhesive to install. Press the device firmly towards the desk to secure it, without touching the sensors or buttons.

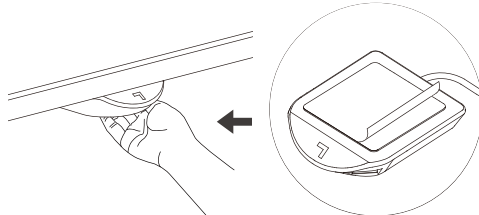
