<p>The sample was placed 0.8m & 1.5m for the measurement below & above 1GHz above the ground plane of 3m chamber. Measurements in both horizontal and vertical polarities were performed. During the test, each emission was maximized by: having the EUT continuously working, investigated all operating modes, rotated about all 3 axis (X, Y & Z) and considered typical configuration to obtain worst position, manipulating interconnecting cables, rotating the turntable, varying antenna height from 1m to 4m in both horizontal and vertical polarizations. 4.2. Test Mode

Antenna port conducted and radiated test items were performed according to KDB 971168 D01 Power Meas. License Digital Systems v03r01 with maximum output power. Radiated measurements were performed with rotating EUT in different three orthogonal test planes to find the maximum emission.

Radiated emissions were investigated as following frequency range:

1. 30 MHz to 10000 MHz for GSM850.
2. 30 MHz to 20000 MHz for PCS1900.

All modes and data rates and positions were investigated.

Test modes are chosen to be reported as the worst case configuration below:

Note: The maximum power levels are chosen to test as the worst case configuration as follows:
GPRS multi-slot class 12 mode for GMSK modulation used for all tests. In addition to above worst-case test, below investigating on all data rates and all modes are compliance with each FCC test case which has specific test limits. For spurious emissions at antenna port, the EUT was investigated the band edges on low and high channels, and the unwanted spurious emissions on middle channel for all modes, the results are PASS, then only the worst-results were reported in the test report. The Radiated Spurious emissions for GPRS modes were investigated on the middle channel and the PASS results were not worst than those data tested from the highest power channels.

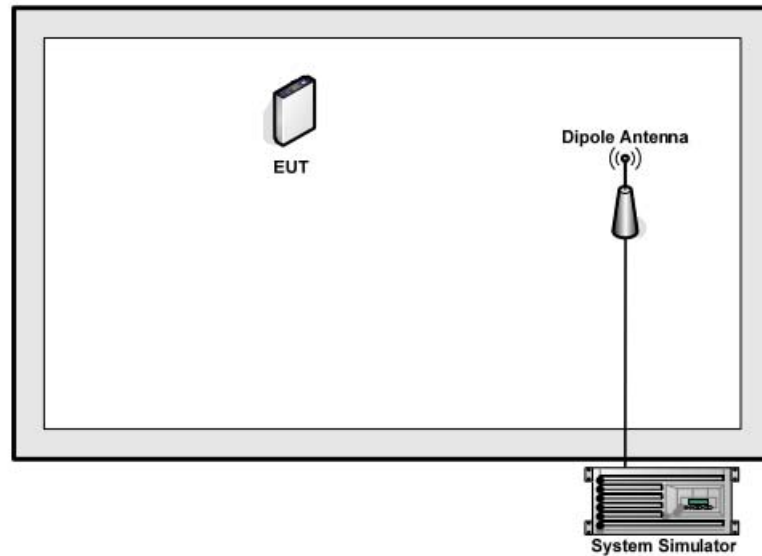

4.5. Measurement Results Explanation Example

For all conducted test items:

The offset level is set in the spectrum analyzer to compensate the RF cable loss and attenuator factor between RF conducted output port and spectrum analyzer. With the offset compensation, the spectrum analyzer reading level will be exactly the RF output level. The spectrum analyzer offset is derived from RF cable loss and attenuator factor.

Offset = RF cable loss + attenuator factor.

The following shows an offset computation example with RF cable loss 3 dB and a 5dB attenuator.

Example: $\text{Offset (dB)} = \text{RF cable loss (dB)} + \text{attenuator factor (dB)}$.



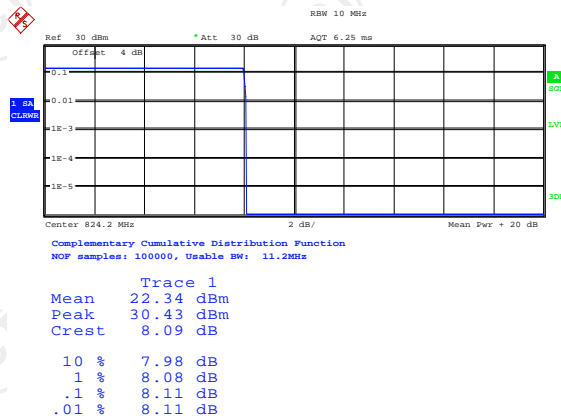

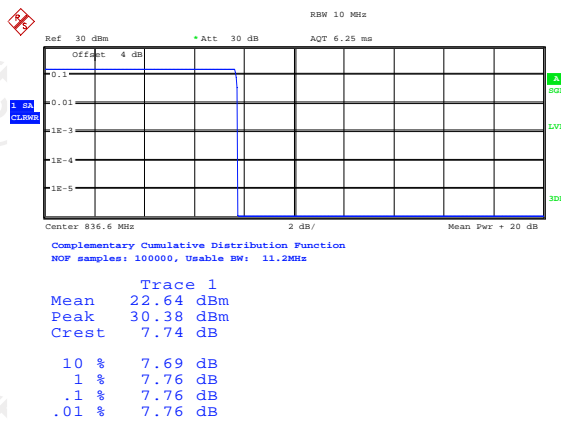

Peak-to-Average Ratio on Channel 128



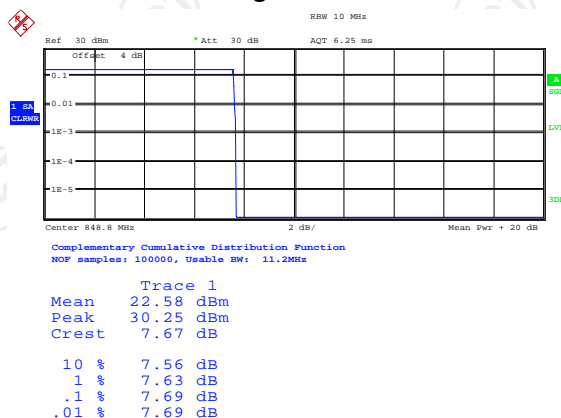

Peak-to-Average Ratio on Channel 190



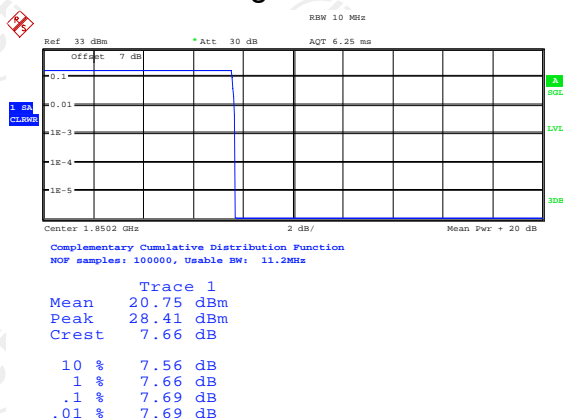

Peak-to-Average Ratio on Channel 251



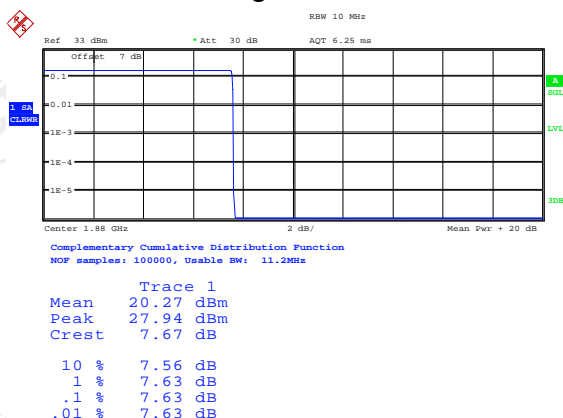

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26dB&99% Occupied Bandwidth Plot on Channel 128



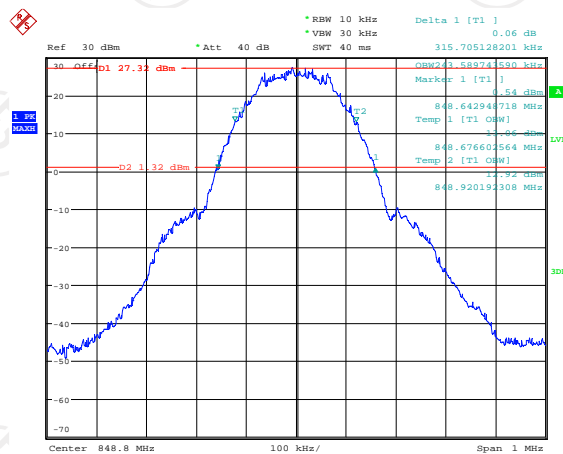

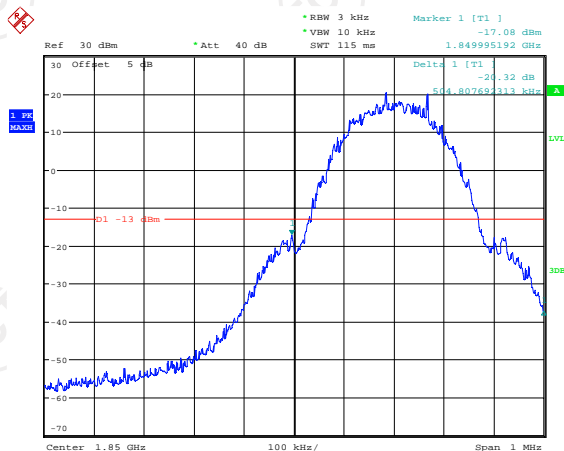
Higher Band Edge Plot on Channel 251

Conducted Spurious Emission on Channel 190

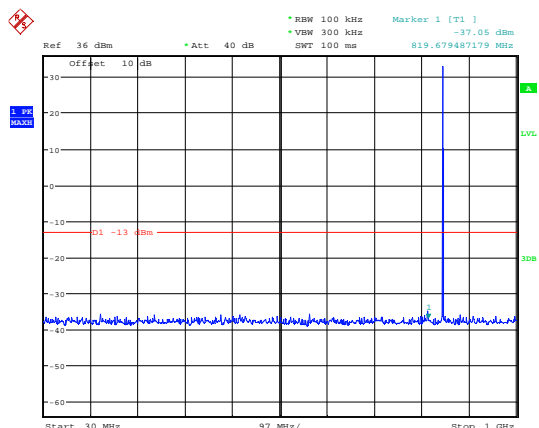


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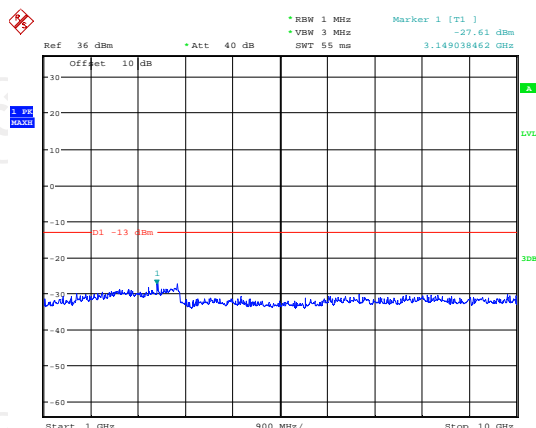

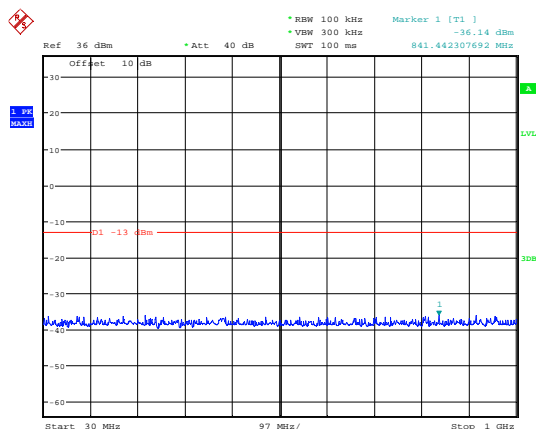


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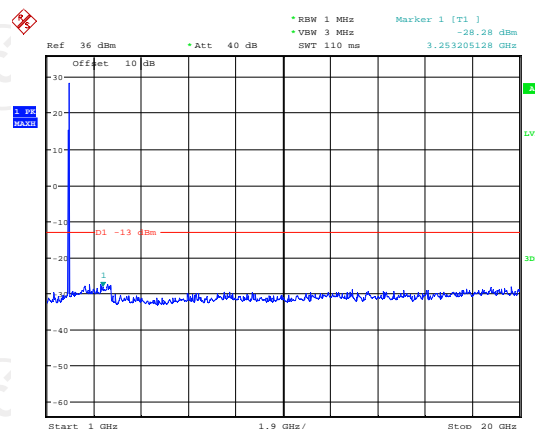


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Conducted Spurious Emission on Channel 661

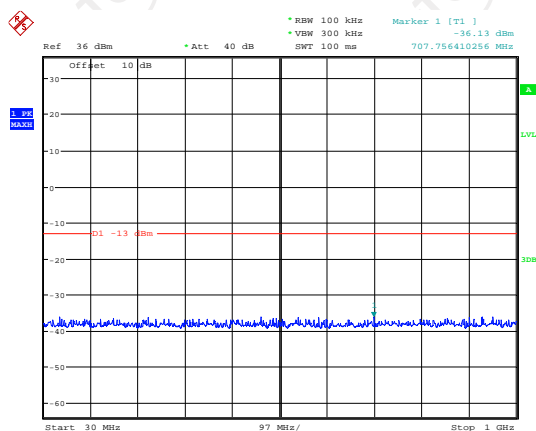


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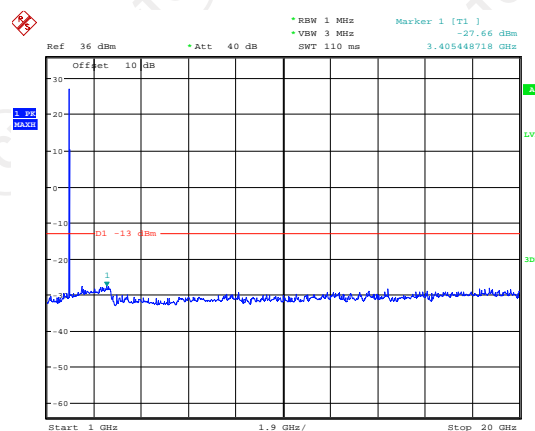
