# **Safety Information**

### **Caution**


- **a.** Do not place the unit on an unstable surface as it may fall and break or cause damage to people or pets.



#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

## • Wireless BT Pairing Mode:

Press MODE or Blue button on the unit or the remote control until BT is selected.

- 1. Put the cell phone within 20 meters;
- **2.**Activate the BT features on your cell phone so that the cell phone starts to search for the BT device. Please refer to the users' manual for details
- 3. Select the correct model No. from the device found by the cell phone;
- **4.** Shortly press PLAY/PAUSE button to play or pause music. Short press "or "key to select the previous or next track.

### •LINE IN MODE:

Press MODE button on the unit or the remote control until LINE is selected. Play the music of the device connected to the LINE input.

### • USB Mode:

- **1.** After start up, press MODE to select "USB" and insert the USB device. The unit will automatically read and play the music in the USB device.
- 2. Press " key shortly to pause or play.
- **3.** Shortly press "key to the previous song.
- **4.** Shortly press "key to the next song.
