TROUBLE SHOOTING

SAFTY MEASURE

- 1. Put the speaker in a ventilated place, and keep the vent a distance from the wall, not blocked.
- 2.Do not put the speaker near fire or a hot object.
- 3. Avoid liquid falling or flowing onto the speaker
- 4.Dont compress or scrape the power cable. Pull out the power cable after using or recharging.
- 5.Pull out the plug immediately if peculiar smell or smoke is discovered, then stop using and repair.
- 6.Do not open speaker without professional proposal, as there is high voltage installation inside.
- 7.Do not use a volatile liquid to clean the speaker, such as alcohol, coating, diluents, or petrol. Use a dry and clean cloth.

Front panel operation instruction

- 1. VOLUME: To adjust the main volume.
- 2.CARD: SD card reader.
- 3.USB: USB reader
- 4 .Remote Receiving window (in the front board, some models do not have remote control)

Rear panel operation instruction

- 1. Power switch: Used to open or close the speaker power.
- 2. Power Input Line is used to supply the speaker inner power.
